OVERVIEW

Shestakov Yacht Sales, represented by broker Andrey Shestakov, introduces the Everglades 255 Center Console — a straightforward motor yacht built in the center console class on a fiberglass and plastic hull. At 25 ft (7.62 m) LOA and a 9 ft (2.82 m) beam, powered by a single Yamaha engine with 154 gallons of fuel capacity, it provides a capable and uncomplicated platform for on water recreation.

Selecting a 255 Center Console

Opt for the 255 Center Console when you prefer a center-console layout coupled with single engine simplicity and the construction quality associated with Everglades. Positioned in the center console segment of motor yachts, it strikes a balance between manageable dimensions and practical functionality for day trips and light fishing duties.

Q: What type of yacht is the 255 Center Console by Everglades? A: It is classified as a motor yacht within the center console category. Those **type** and **class** labels reflect its center console arrangement and single engine power setup.

Q: What are the LOA and beam of the 255 Center Console? A: The vessel measures **25 ft (7.62 m)** LOA and has a **beam** of **9 ft (2.82 m)**.

Q: What is the draft range? A: The **draft** varies from a minimum of **5.195 ft**

(1.5833 m) to a maximum of **8.749 ft (2.6666 m)** .

Q: What powers the boat? A: The 255 Center Console is fitted with a **single engine** supplied by **Yamaha** (1 x Yamaha).

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The **hull** is constructed of fiberglass and plastic, and the **deck** is Fiberglass. For offers and further information, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Owner Experience Review

Owners report using the 255 Center Console from Everglades for family outings and weekend escapes; one purchaser described the transaction as “the best boat purchasing experience I’ve ever had.” The boat also serves effectively as a compact fishing platform for nearshore and light offshore work, with at least one owner in Key West praising its shallow water capability on the Gulf side while still being competent in Atlantic conditions.

On the water, the Deep V Dougherty hull is credited with a reassuring, solid feel in choppy seas; reviewers have run it in 3–5' waves and noted soft, controlled touchdowns and predictable tracking. Published Yamaha figures for a twin F250 setup indicate roughly 38.3 mph at 4,000 rpm and about 57.2 mph at 5,800 rpm, with a 0–30 mph time near 5.84 seconds. Owners emphasize that low speed manners, porpoising tendencies, and fuel consumption are often influenced by engine mounting position and prop choice, and many owners fine tune those items to optimize performance.

For everyday use, the layout supports both fishing and family needs: there is a below console marine head with macerator and service access, ample fish and ice capacity including an approximately 85 gallon forward fishbox, an aft fishbox and livewell, plus a forward seat that stores a large 94 quart cooler. Fit and finish receive positive remarks from owners, who also note the boat is

quick and handles rough water confidently.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V Dougherty hull delivers a confident ride in 3–5' chop with soft landings and stable tracking.
- Versatile for family cruising, nearshore/light offshore fishing, and skinny water inshore runs.
- Thoughtful fish/ice storage, livewell layout, and a below console head with good access.
- Economy, low speed handling, and porpoising are sensitive to engine mounting height and prop selection.
- Saltwater exhaust manifolds/risers need periodic inspection and can fail in 2–5 years if neglected.
- Maintenance follows typical twin outboard service routines.
