OVERVIEW

The 290 Center Console by Everglades is a flexible motor platform centered on a center console layout and built on a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull. At 29 ft (8.86 m) overall with a 9 ft (2.97 m) beam, it offers balanced dimensions suited to confident outings. Presented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Selecting a 290 Center Console

Opt for the 290 Center Console if a center console configuration, twin Yamaha outboard power, and well matched capacities are priorities. As a motor yacht, this model comes equipped with two Yamaha gasoline outboards, a 200 gallon fuel tank and a 25 gallon water tank to support day trips and sport fishing hours. Questions and Answers

- What type of yacht is the 290 Center Console? The 290 Center Console is a motor yacht constructed around a center console layout and produced by Everglades. Its **classification** , **layout** , and **builder** reflect a design focused on functionality.
- What are the principal dimensions? The vessel's **LOA** measures 29 ft (8.86 m),

the **beam** is 9 ft (2.97 m), and the **minimum draft** is 5.741 ft (1.75 m).

- What engines power this model? Propulsion is provided by two **Yamaha outboard** engines running on **gas** .
- What onboard amenities and materials stand out? The boat includes 1 **head** for convenience, a **Fiberglass** deck, and a fiberglass and plastic hull structure.
- What are the fuel and water capacities? The **fuel capacity** is 200 gal and the **water capacity** is 25 gal.

Owner Experience Review

Owners operating the 290 Center Console from Everglades commonly praise it as a capable offshore platform that adapts well to family use. In challenging inlet conditions, users credit the deep V hull—featuring a sharp forward entry that eases to roughly 21 degrees at the transom—with preventing the bow from burying and producing gentle landings, consistent with the model's reputation for a forgiving ride. Independent sea trials with twin 225 hp four stroke engines documented a 49.4 mph top speed and an economical cruise near 37.6 mph at 4,500 rpm, consuming about 21.5 gph, which supports efficient runs to fishing grounds and back.

For everyday use the layout and shelter are useful across roles. An enclosed head, a tall integrated windshield with wiper and vents, wraparound bolster seating and a stout leaning post helm all enhance comfort for family outings and weekend hops. Anglers appreciate practical features such as an approximate 66 gallon livewell at the bait station, dual bow rod lockers, and roomy cockpit fish and ice storage; the Pilot house version receives frequent compliments for its added protection from the elements. Owners do note some caveats: the boat tends to require higher speeds/RPMs to remain on plane and can feel temperamental below about 3,800 rpm, making prop choice and trim settings especially important. When poor planing or RPM imbalance occurs, troubleshooting sometimes finds prop mismatch or ignition coil/plug

faults. Routine maintenance typically includes 100 hour engine servicing, fresh bottom paint and zinc replacement, and a minority of owners report persistent moisture in fish boxes or storage that was difficult to fully dry.

Pros and Cons

- Sea kindly deep V ride that keeps the bow from stuffing and lands softly in large seas.
- Serious fishing layout with integrated hardtop, ~66 gallon livewell, ample rod and fish/ice storage.
- Versatile for family weekends with an enclosed head and tall protective windshield; Pilot house variant adds more shelter.
- Requires higher speed/RPM to stay on plane and can feel finicky below ~3,800 rpm.
- Performance at low speeds is highly sensitive to prop selection and engine setup.
- Some owners report persistent water ingress in fish boxes/storage.
