OVERVIEW

The 325 Center Console from Everglades is an offshore-capable platform designed as part of the motor yacht range and engineered specifically as a center console yacht. Measuring 34 ft (10.52 m) overall with a 10 ft (3.2 m) beam, fitted with twin Yamaha gas outboards and a single practical head, it serves well for spirited day runs and sport-focused outings. Owner Experience Review

Owners of the 325 Center Console from Everglades commonly split their time between offshore canyon runs and leisurely family outings; the boat is capable in both roles without compromising either use. Third-party test reports have labeled it canyon-capable, and comments from dealers and owners point to a large fishing cockpit with a dedicated fish box and livewell while still maintaining comfortable accommodations.

On the water, feedback highlights a composed, solid ride that remains comfortable in choppy conditions, with testers noting secure handling in waves and gentle re-entries. Performance figures depend heavily on the propulsion selected: published listings and trial runs indicate cruising speeds in the high 30-knot range, with one 2014 listing reporting roughly a 37-knot cruise and a 60-knot top speed after repowering to Yamaha 425 XTOs; actual performance will vary by engine choice and overall setup.

Amenities for day cruising include an enclosed head, a hydraulic sliding windshield, quality upholstery, and an ergonomically designed, factory-completed console. Anglers will appreciate a cockpit reported to be around 131 sq ft, equipped with an 80-gallon fish box and a 34-gallon livewell, offering serious fishability without sacrificing comfort for family use.

Ownership commentary emphasizes the rugged RAMCAP construction and the importance of following routine maintenance per the manufacturer's manual; electronics upgrades are common (for example, a radar repair has been quoted at about \$500), and many used examples show engine updates or full repowers. Prospective buyers of older boats are frequently advised to carefully inspect early runs of 350 hp outboards.

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, confidence-inspiring offshore ride with notably soft re-entries reported during tests.
- Serious fishing capability with approximately 131 sq ft of cockpit space plus an 80-gal fish box and a 34-gal livewell.
- Family-friendly creature comforts such as an enclosed head, a hydraulic sliding windshield, and a well-arranged helm layout.
- Electronics upgrades and occasional radar/MFD repairs are common ownership considerations that add to operating costs.
- Numerous pre-owned boats show engine updates or complete repowers, indicating potential future drivetrain expenditures.
- Real-world speed and fuel efficiency vary considerably depending on engine selection and overall package, so performance is package-dependent.
