- You prioritize twin Yamaha outboards running on **gas** for sharp responsiveness and straightforward servicing.
- A 34 ft (10.52 m) LOA with a 10 ft (3.2 m) beam matches common slip, trailer, and marina requirements.
- A substantial 306 gal fuel tank minimizes refueling stops, while 38 gal of water supports typical onboard needs.
- Professional assistance from Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales simplifies selection, negotiation, survey coordination, and delivery logistics.

- Constructed by Everglades to emphasize robust outboard propulsion and efficiently arranged deck areas.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers frequently describe the 335 Center Console from Everglades as a genuinely dual-purpose platform: configured for offshore sportfishing with capacious fishboxes and designated tackle and rod storage, yet equally suited to family cruising and relaxed sandbar days. On the water, users praise its confident handling and composed ride, attributes attributed to Everglades' RAMCAP hull construction and a 25° transom deadrise; one owner even likened the feel to a larger vessel while retaining nimble manners. When equipped with high-output twin engines (examples include Mercury 400 or Yamaha 425/450), acceleration and top speed are notably strong, and options such as joystick control and helm assist are available on later builds.

Comfort and onboard layout receive consistent positive remarks from owners who use the boat for entertaining and day trips. Features like convertible bow backrests, an enlarged fold-down transom seat, insulated coolers, and a full

head make the platform family-oriented, while aftermarket and factory options—Seakeeper gyro-stabilizer and an upper station, for instance—have generated enthusiastic feedback. A 2024 update introduced more comfortable interior finishes and refined seating and helm ergonomics compared with earlier iterations, enhancing both long fishing expeditions and casual cruising.

Practical ownership considerations align with the boat's performance package: routine maintenance costs can be higher with twin high-output outboards, so solid dealer and service networks are important for many buyers. There are isolated reports of center-console drainage issues and instances of deck damage where aftermarket fixtures were installed or removed.

Counterbalancing those concerns, documentation often notes a 10-year hull warranty and the availability of service manuals, and some owners commend responsive dealer and factory support.

Pros and Cons

- Confident, smooth offshore ride credited to the RAMCAP hull and 25° deadrise.
- Serious angling setup with large fishboxes and dedicated tackle/rod storage.
- Versatile, family-friendly layout and options (Seakeeper, upper station, full head) for day cruising and entertaining.
- Routine upkeep is costlier due to twin high-output outboards.
- Isolated owner reports note center-console drainage concerns.
- Deck damage can occur if aftermarket fittings are added or removed without care.
