Owner Experience Review

As someone who owns and operates one, I appreciate how the 365 Center Console from Everglades adapts seamlessly from offshore tournament work to relaxed family outings. The capacious cockpit, generous fish boxes, and well sized livewells make it a true fishing platform, while the forward lounge, quality upholstery, roomy head, and available galley/refrigeration options elevate comfort for cruising and occasional overnight stays. I've also observed this hull perform well as an upscale day charter vessel and as a reliable chase boat.

On the water, the RAMCAP hull provides a strong yet quiet and notably dry ride, with composed, stable behavior at cruising speeds. With an appropriate outboard package plus optional joystick/helm assist systems, it remains straightforward for a single owner to handle; typical cruising speeds sit in the 30–40+ mph band, varying with whether the installation is twin or triple outboards. Maintenance follows the expected pattern for multiple outboards: routine oil, gear lube, impeller, and filter servicing accumulates, and triple setups increase ongoing costs. Service access is eased by Everglades' molded in rigging troughs and the no wood construction, though add ons like a Seakeeper and premium electronics broaden the service scope and call for occasional software updates.

Pros and Cons

- Dry, smooth offshore ride with confident handling at cruise.
- Versatile layout supports serious fishing and family weekending with plush seating, lounge space, and a spacious head.
- Thoughtful rigging access and no wood construction make systems checks and service more straightforward.
- Triple outboard setups raise recurring maintenance costs and service time.
- Optional Seakeeper and advanced electronics add complexity and require periodic service and software updates.
- Real world cruise speed depends on the engine package, with twin installations typically trailing triple powered setups.
