OVERVIEW

Shestakov Yacht Sales, led by broker Andrey Shestakov, presents the 435 Center Console from Everglades—a capable motor yacht in the center console segment. Built on a Deep Vee hull of fiberglass and plastic, this 45 ft LOA, 12 ft beam center console is outfitted with four Yamaha outboards and designed for confident coastal cruising and active day boating.

Selecting a 435 Center Console

If your brief calls for a larger center console that blends a performance-oriented hull with uncomplicated outboard power, the 435 Center Console is a strong contender. Measuring 45 ft (13.72 m) LOA with a 12 ft (3.66 m) beam, it delivers an expansive deck footprint. The Deep Vee hull teamed with four Yamaha outboards running on gas creates the kind of propulsion and hull pairing many center console buyers seek. Add a single practical head and generous fuel and water stores, and the model becomes a persuasive option within the motor yacht category.

- Constructed by Everglades as a premium platform in the center console yacht class
- Deep Vee running surface engineered for reassuring seakeeping in offshore conditions
- Hull fashioned from fiberglass and plastic with a fiberglass deck for durability and finish
- Powered by four Yamaha outboards using gas fuel to emphasize straightforward servicing and dependable performance
- A single onboard head to support comfortable day-cruising operations

- LOA of 45 ft (13.72 m) and beam of 12 ft (3.66 m) to maximize usable deck and cockpit area
- Significant capacities: 610 gallons of fuel and 75 gallons of fresh water for extended runs

Q: What type of yacht is the 435 Center Console? A: It is a motor yacht

categorized as a center console yacht with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a Deep Vee hull form.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA** is 45 ft (13.72 m), the **beam** measures 12 ft (3.66 m), and the **draft** is listed from 7.655 ft (2.3333 m) up to 10.389 ft (3.1666 m).

Q: What engines power this model? A: It is driven by four **Yamaha Outboard** engines running on **Gas** —a quad-engine outboard arrangement for robust propulsion and handling.

Q: What capacities and accommodations are on board? A: Fuel capacity is 610 gal and fresh water capacity is 75 gal. The boat includes **1 head** to support day-cruising comfort.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers characterize the 435 Center Console from Everglades as a genuine offshore-capable 360° walk-around fishing platform that also adapts well to family cruising and short getaways. The design balances plentiful rod and gear storage and bait/prep spaces with an ample forward social area: U-shaped seating for five that converts via a powered table into a sun pad, a roomy cockpit, and twin-row helm seating arrangements.

Underway, the variable deep-V hull (25° at the transom) built with RAMCAP technology is credited with delivering a quiet, solid offshore ride and confident handling in heavy seas. Documented top runs include roughly 57 mph with a quad F350 installation, making the boat suitable for longer day trips and island

hops, including Bahamas passages. Many owners enhance offshore comfort and onboard systems with options such as a Seakeeper, generator installations, or cosmetic upgrade packages to tailor ride comfort and presentation.

Pros and Cons

- Offshore ride quality is notably smooth and quiet; the deep-V (25° transom) hull and RAMCAP construction provide steady, confident handling in larger seas.
- True 360° walk-around deck layout combines excellent fishability with generous forward lounge seating and dual-row helm seating for versatile day use.
- The compact cabin containing a head, sink, microwave, fridge, and berth supports weekending and extended island runs.
- The quad outboard propulsion and optional systems like Seakeeper and genset contribute to elevated ongoing operating and maintenance expenses.
- Owners reported some production- and wiring-related issues in mid-2010s examples, with indications that Everglades addressed many of those concerns in later builds.
- Occasional minor component annoyances are mentioned by owners, such as Gemlux hardware issues and intermittent livewell seal leaks.

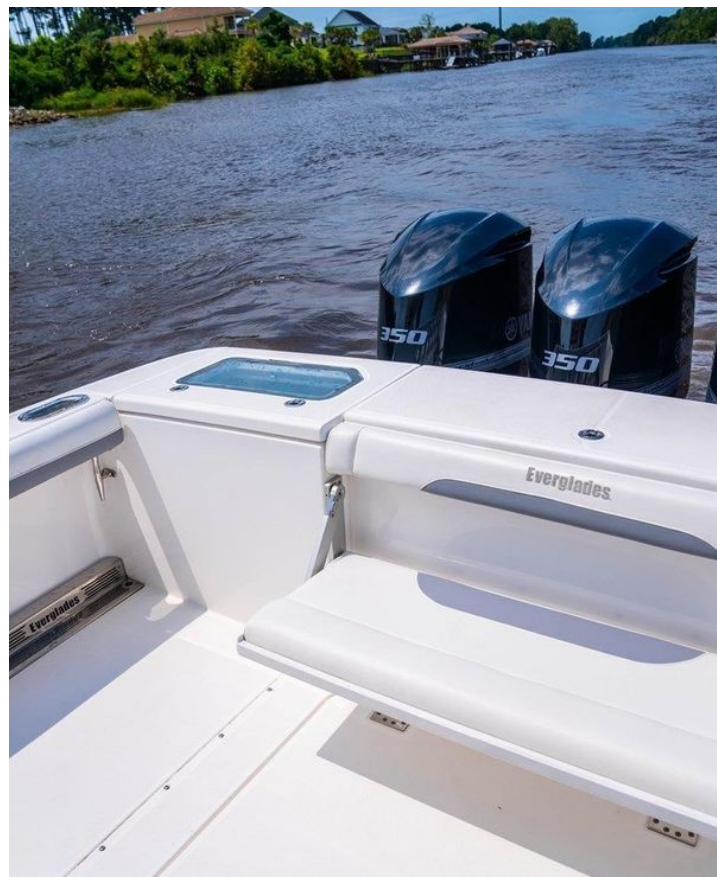

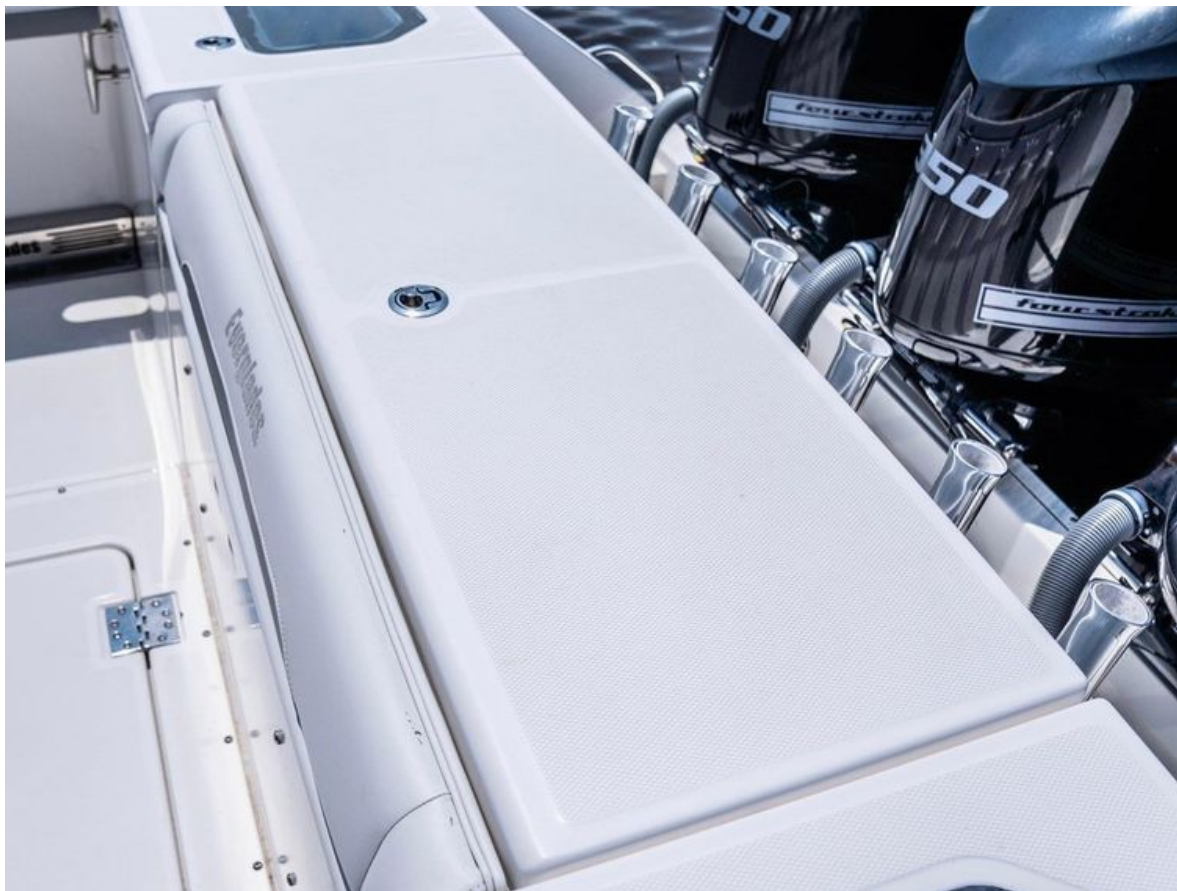
