OVERVIEW

The 455 CC from Everglades is a multi-role sport fisherman in the upscale motor yacht segment, built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck. Equipped with three Mercury outboards, it achieves a 39 kn cruise (44.88 mph) and reaches up to 53 kn (60.99 mph), while carrying 683 gallons of fuel and 100 gallons of freshwater for extended outings. When speed, nimble handling, and serious fishability are priorities in a motor yacht that doubles as a dedicated sport fisherman, the 455 CC is an excellent candidate. Its 45 ft LOA and 13 ft beam create a stable platform with generous deck workspace, while the triple Mercury outboards and Gas/Petrol power offer strong acceleration and economical cruise performance. Constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck, the design balances durability and maintenance ease with dynamic capability. Questions and Answers

Q: What are the performance figures of the 455 CC? A: The yacht posts a **cruise speed** of 39 kn (44.88 mph) and a **max speed** of 53 kn (60.99 mph), driven by a trio of Mercury outboards for assured performance.

Q: What **engines** power the 455 CC? A: It is fitted with 3 x Mercury **Outboard** engines running on **Gas/Petrol** , providing brisk acceleration and efficient

cruising.

Q: What are the key **dimensions** and **draft** ? A: **LOA** measures 45 ft (13.72 m) and the **beam** is 13 ft (4.04 m). **Draft** is listed from approximately 9.843 ft (3 m) minimum to 13.397 ft (4.0833 m) maximum.

Q: What is the **hull** and **deck** construction? A: The hull is constructed of fiberglass and plastic, and the **deck** consists of Fiberglass.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers commonly describe the 455 CC from Everglades as a flagship introduced for the 2022 model year, with production beginning in 2022, targeted at avid anglers who also desire true overnight/liveaboard amenities. Its offshore angling features are comprehensive—large insulated fish boxes, a pair of 50-gallon livewells, more than 40 rod holders, and boarding doors on both port and starboard—while the social and comfort aspects include a spacious cockpit, ample seating, and high-end entertainment options. Test boats configured for extended cruising included cabin A/C, a 15 kW generator, and a 100-gallon freshwater tank; reviewers highlighted genuine overnight comfort.

On the water, the deep-V hull has been trialed in 3–8' seas and is reported to settle softly through waves, drawing feedback such as “Incredible!” and “More agile than I expected!” with many calling the boat “peppy” and “sportboat-like” for its size. Its long waterline, roughly 28,000 lb dry displacement, and a 13'3" beam enable it to carry substantial loads of people and gear while preserving

composure; multiple reviewers praised its offshore confidence and noted an absence of hard slamming.

From the ownership perspective, Everglades' reputation for stout, overbuilt construction and generally good access earns high marks—one forum poster even cited them as a favorite to service—though the yacht's complexity does increase the list of maintenance items. Quad-outboard setups raise recurring 100/300-hour service frequency and costs, and test boats fitted with Seakeeper add service considerations such as raw-water pump and electrical checks and freshwater rinsing to limit corrosion. For many owners, the balance is a center console that merges bluewater angling capability, premium fit and finish, and authentic cruising comfort.

Pros and Cons

- Confident rough-water ride and agile handling in 3–8' seas, with a deep-V that lands softly.
- True overnight/liveaboard capability with cabin and helm A/C, a 15 kW generator, and a 100-gallon freshwater tank.
- Offshore angling setup with large fish boxes, two 50-gallon livewells, 40+ rod holders, and dual boarding doors.
- Complex systems package (generator, A/C, Seakeeper, digital switching) adds to service tasks over time.
- Quad-outboard configurations carry higher recurring 100/300-hour maintenance costs and labor.
- Seakeeper gyro introduces additional upkeep, including raw-water pump and electrical checks plus freshwater rinsing.

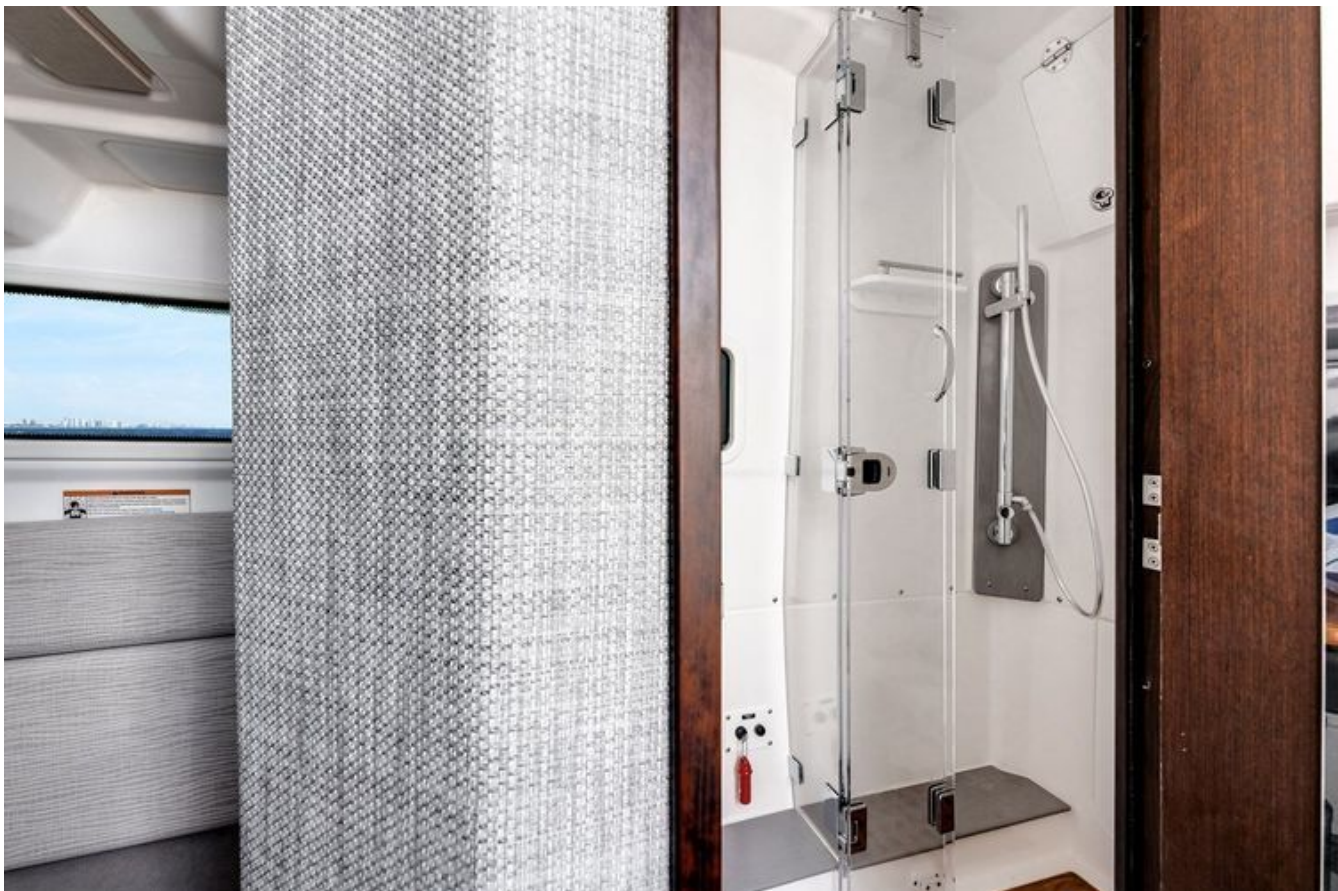
