## OVERVIEW

---

The CUSTOM from FeadShip is a fully bespoke motor yacht in the mega yacht class, built with a steel yacht hull and steel decks. Measuring 164 ft (49.99 m) LOA with a 30 ft (9.29 m) beam and a volume of 656 GT, she offers comfortable cruising at 12 kn (13.81 mph) and a top speed of 15 kn (17.26 mph). For buyers focused on a steel built vessel within the mega yacht class, the CUSTOM by FeadShip represents a combination of time proven shipyard expertise, substantial internal volume (656 GT) and dependable twin engine performance. ## Questions and Answers

---

- Q: What type of yacht is the CUSTOM? A: It is a fully custom motor yacht in the mega yacht class, constructed with a steel yacht hull by FeadShip.

- Q: How large is the yacht? A: **Dimensions** are 164 ft (49.99 m) LOA with a 30 ft (9.29 m) beam and a **draft** of 9.908 ft (3.02 m), yielding a **gross tonnage** of 656 GT.
- Q: What are the performance figures? A: **Cruising speed** is 12 kn (13.81 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 15 kn (17.26 mph), powered by 2 x Caterpillar engines.
- Q: How many people can stay onboard? A: **Accommodation** is arranged for up to 12 guests, supported by **crew berths** for 7 crew members.
- Q: Who built and designed the yacht and what materials are used? A: Built by FeadShip with **interiors by Glade Johnson Design** ; the hull is a steel yacht and the **deck** is Steel. For full specifications and details contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners who have commissioned a CUSTOM from FeadShip frequently describe the result as a floating family residence, with an emphasis on effortless circulation between interiors and generous outdoor living spaces. Typical owner briefs favour multiple bar areas, expansive alfresco decks and dedicated wellness zones; individual owners often specify distinctive elements such as contraflow pools, broad terraces and bespoke furniture tailored for fitness, children and toy storage. Notable builds including ROCK.IT, Vanish and Moon Sand show how closely FeadShip can interpret a client's lifestyle brief.

On passage, owners of full custom FeadShips commonly praise their seakeeping—capable of comfortable long distance passages, ocean crossings and extended seasons aboard. At anchor and during close manoeuvres these yachts are often cited for their quiet operation and precise handling, supported by well integrated control systems; as one owner put it, “When the doors slide open on the main deck, every time I come in there it just blows me away!”

The highly bespoke nature of some onboard systems can introduce complexity. One circumnavigation oriented yacht (SHINKAI) experienced gyroscopic stabiliser cut outs in severe conditions, producing rolls of about 40°; the yard subsequently added conventional fin stabilisers to improve high speed stability. Owners also report that failures in custom systems can result in extended downtime—nearly a year of repairs was cited in that example. FeadShip offers owner support and refit initiatives (for instance, “My Feadship”), and refit/forum accounts suggest that older FeadShip yachts may need substantial refits with correspondingly high operating and refurbishment costs.

## Pros and Cons

- Excellent seakeeping is commonly reported on long passages and ocean crossings.
- Quiet, accurate station keeping and manoeuvring with low noise levels at anchor.
- Strong emphasis on highly personalised, residential interiors and large outdoor living zones.
- Complex, bespoke systems (for example, gyroscopic stabilisers) can be vulnerable in heavy seas.
- Repairs to unique systems can be protracted and expensive, with some cases taking nearly a year.
- Older FeadShip builds may demand major refits, and owners discuss significant operating and refit expenses.
