OVERVIEW

Stretching 73 ft (22.3 m) overall, the 720 from Ferretti Yachts combines engineering by the Ferretti Engineering Department with interior styling from the Ferretti Group to create a polished motor yacht. Its swift fiberglass and plastic hull in a planing configuration, driven by twin inboard MAN diesel engines, produces a 28 knot cruising speed (32.22 mph) and a top speed near 32 kn (36.83 mph).

Selecting a 720

If you seek a yacht that harmonizes speed, economy, and onboard comfort, the 720 stands out in the motor yacht segment. The 18 ft (5.7 m) beam increases interior volume, while the layout supports up to 8 guests with 6 berths, 4 heads, and 2 crew berths — suitable for long-range cruising or lively day trips. Shestakov Yacht Sales — and broker Andrey Shestakov — can assist with locating available boats, arranging sea trials, and specifying the right options for your use.

- Planing-hull performance delivering a 28 kn (32.22 mph) cruising pace and a 32 kn (36.83 mph) maximum.
- Twin inboard MAN diesel engines provide responsive and dependable propulsion.
- Exterior naval architecture by Ferretti Engineering Department with interiors crafted by Ferretti Group.
- 73 ft LOA and an 18 ft beam, with a minimum draft of 5.906 ft (1.8 m) to allow flexible coastal access.
- Sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull paired with a fiberglass deck.

- Comfortable sleeping arrangements for up to 8 guests, including 6 berths, 4 heads, and 2 crew berths.
- Cruising-oriented tankage with a fuel capacity of 1215.19 gal and fresh water capacity of 264.17 gal.

Questions and Answers

Q: What are the performance figures of the 720? A: The vessel achieves a **cruising speed** of 28 kn (32.22 mph) and a **top speed** of 32 kn (36.83 mph), propelled by twin inboard **MAN diesel engines** .

Q: How many people can the 720 accommodate? A: The layout provides **accommodations** for up to 8 guests, with **sleeps** for 6, **4 heads** , and **2 crew** berths to support extended passages.

Q: What are the dimensions and draft? A: The yacht measures **LOA** 73 ft (22.3 m), has a **beam** of 18 ft (5.7 m), and a minimum **draft** of 5.906 ft (1.8 m).

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: Construction features a fiberglass and plastic hull in a **planing** form with a **fiberglass** deck.

Q: Who designed and built the yacht, and how do I purchase through Shestakov Yacht Sales? A: The hull was penned by **Ferretti Engineering Department** , interiors by **Ferretti Group** , and the yacht is built by Ferretti Yachts. Owner Experience Review

Owners who choose the Ferretti Yachts 720 often prioritize family cruising and sociable deck life. The four-cabin layout, including a full-beam owner's suite, provides the volume to welcome up to eight people, and the expansive 30 m² flybridge plus a useful foredeck are frequently applauded for entertaining. The model is a common sight in Mediterranean charter programs, and many reviewers find it manageable for an experienced owner-operator on weekend

hops.

Underway, owners describe the boat as “gentle”: sea trials report predictable handling, modest vibration and acceptable noise when cruising in the mid 20s knots, with peak speeds quoted up to about 32 knots depending on engine selection. Close-quarters maneuvering is generally straightforward, and the planing hull combined with stabilizers produces comfortable passages in typical Mediterranean chop. While it isn’t aimed at hardcore sportfishing, owners do use the yacht for light fishing and towing water toys.

Practical ownership observations are positive. Trials and owner reports note a large, walk-around engine room that simplifies routine servicing, and some forum owners of older Ferrettis cite years of reliable operation; listings for a 2002 Ferretti Yachts 720 commonly praise the elegant styling, spacious interiors and solid performance. Nevertheless, systems such as the power glass/patio door and hydraulic platforms are complex and can require attention, and typical 70 ft Italian flybridge maintenance—stabilizers, hydraulics, HVAC and MAN engine service—should be budgeted for.

Pros and Cons

- Four-cabin arrangement with a full-beam owner’s suite that accommodates family cruising and hosting up to eight guests.
- Generous, flexible 30 m² flybridge and an inviting foredeck that facilitate entertaining.
- Predictable handling, quiet cruising at higher speeds, and accessible port maneuvers make owner-operator use feasible.
- Not configured as a dedicated sportfisher, so it lacks advanced fishing features and heavy-duty angling gear.
- Some owners report limited salon headroom and intrusive door sills.
- Advanced systems such as the powered glass door, hydraulic platforms, and

other large-yacht systems increase maintenance and service requirements.
