Owner Experience Review

Owners and charter operators typically use the 760 by Ferretti Yachts as a 4 cabin/8 guest family cruiser, most often paired with two crew cabins. Listings and charter records highlight a generous salon and multiple sunpads, and a number of hulls have established track records on Mediterranean week long charters with a three person crew. For private short breaks, many find it manageable owner operated with 2–3 crew, with cockpit and flybridge zones that lend themselves to effortless entertaining.

On the water, owners report a deep V planing hull that yields a composed and confidence inspiring ride in typical Mediterranean conditions. Reported cruising pace is a comfortable 23 knots, with full throttle speeds into the low 30s, and the flybridge is regularly lauded for its sightlines and functional layout—“one of the very best flybridges in that size bracket,” according to a forum comment.

Ownership notes caution on several service items. Some examples have shown GRP fuel tank internal coating deterioration that can foul filters, and replacement of the large hull glazing can be expensive if required. Many boats undergo periodic refits covering engines, gensets, and HVAC systems; with

MTU, CAT, or MAN powerplants historically specified, spare parts and major engine overhauls are significant budget items that warrant careful review of service records.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile 4 cabin/8 guest arrangement with two crew cabins suits both family cruising and charter operations.
- Deep V planing hull provides a composed, confidence inspiring motion with an easy 23 knot cruise.
- Cockpit and flybridge deliver popular entertaining areas with strong visibility and ergonomic design.
- Some owners have reported GRP fuel tank coating flaking that can clog fuel filters.
- Large hull windows are costly to replace if damaged or degraded.
- Periodic refits and substantial engine work (MTU/CAT/MAN) can represent notable ownership expenses.
