## OVERVIEW

---

The 850 Motoryacht from Ferretti Yachts is an elegant motor yacht built on a sturdy fiberglass-and-plastic hull designed to deliver confident handling and onboard comfort. Listed and marketed by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this model combines performance, generous interior volume, and Italian styling for owners with exacting standards.

## Selecting a 850 Motoryacht

---

Opting for the 850 Motoryacht prioritizes well-proportioned lines and capable performance. With an LOA of 85 ft (25.91 m) and a 21 ft (6.4 m) beam, the yacht offers both brisk passage making and expansive living areas. Those seeking fast cruising capability alongside substantial onboard space will find the layout appealing, and the inclusion of four heads plus two crew cabins supports extended cruising and professional crew operations.

## Features of the Model

---

- Engineered to blend speed and livability, with a 24 kn cruise and a 30 kn top speed (27.62 mph and 34.52 mph respectively)
- A larger-than-typical footprint in its category, improving stability and interior volume
- Functional accommodation for extended use, featuring 4 heads and 2 crew cabins to ensure guest comfort and full crew service
- Built with longevity in mind: a fiberglass-and-plastic hull paired with a fiberglass deck

## Questions and Answers

---

- Q: What type of yacht is the 850 Motoryacht? A: It is a motor yacht

constructed on a fiberglass-and-plastic hull.

- Q: Who is the builder of this model? A: The 850 Motoryacht is manufactured by Ferretti Yachts.
- Q: How fast does it go? A: The yacht's **cruise speed** is 24 kn (27.62 mph) and its **max speed** is 30 kn (34.52 mph).
- Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: **LOA** measures 85 ft (25.91 m), **beam** is 21 ft (6.4 m), **fuel capacity** is 1,783 gal, **water capacity** is 349 gal, and **gross tonnage** is 85 GT.
- Q: What accommodations support crewed operation? A: The vessel includes **2 crew cabins** and **4 heads** , providing comfortable facilities for professional crew service.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and brokers characterize the 850 Motoryacht from Ferretti Yachts as a practical, family oriented yacht that transitions easily between weekend use and small charter duties. The four cabin, all ensuite arrangement with a full beam owner's stateroom, plus a separate crew zone closed off by a pocket door, delivers meaningful privacy for multigenerational families or groups. Everyday living tends to revolve around the "maxi loft" open salon that admits abundant daylight, while the flybridge and cockpit are frequently praised for their usable outdoor layouts. The convertible garage that doubles as a swim platform simplifies water access and streamlines charter turnarounds.

Underway, owners and sea trial reports note favorable seakeeping for the class and often recommend settling into a relaxed cruise between 8–11 knots, with approximately 8 knots at roughly 750 rpm cited for efficient long passages. In speed trials the 850 Motoryacht has recorded about 29.6–30 knots, with a stated top capability near 31 knots depending on specification of MAN V12s (1,800 or 1,900 hp). Many hulls are fitted with roughly 6,750 liters of fuel—generally seen as sufficient for displacement cruising but restrictive at

planing velocities; some online commentary has even nicknamed them “comedy fuel tanks.”

Feedback from owners also emphasizes maintenance realities. High gloss painted hulls and premium interior finishes present an attractive appearance but require attentive cosmetic upkeep, and brokers and owners typically advise using certified technicians for MAN V12 engines due to parts and service costs. Helpful features like side and exterior engine room access simplify professional servicing, yet substantial modifications—such as installing long range tanks or adding an internal staircase—tend to be involved and expensive. The model has been offered on the market since 2016, with listings continuing through 2023.

## Pros and Cons

---

- “Maxi loft” open plan salon provides generous volume and plentiful natural light for everyday living.
- Four en suite cabins sleeping eight, plus separate crew quarters with a pocket door separation, support family cruising and guest privacy.
- Flybridge and cockpit areas, paired with a convertible garage/swim platform, offer flexible outdoor spaces and charter functionality.
- Typical fuel tanks of about 6,750 L on many boats can restrict range at planing speeds, prompting forum commentary dubbing them “comedy fuel tanks.”
- Painted hulls and upscale finishes increase the demand for regular cosmetic maintenance and detailing over time.
- MAN V12 propulsion generally requires certified servicing and genuine parts, raising operating costs and making major retrofits like long range tanks complex and expensive.

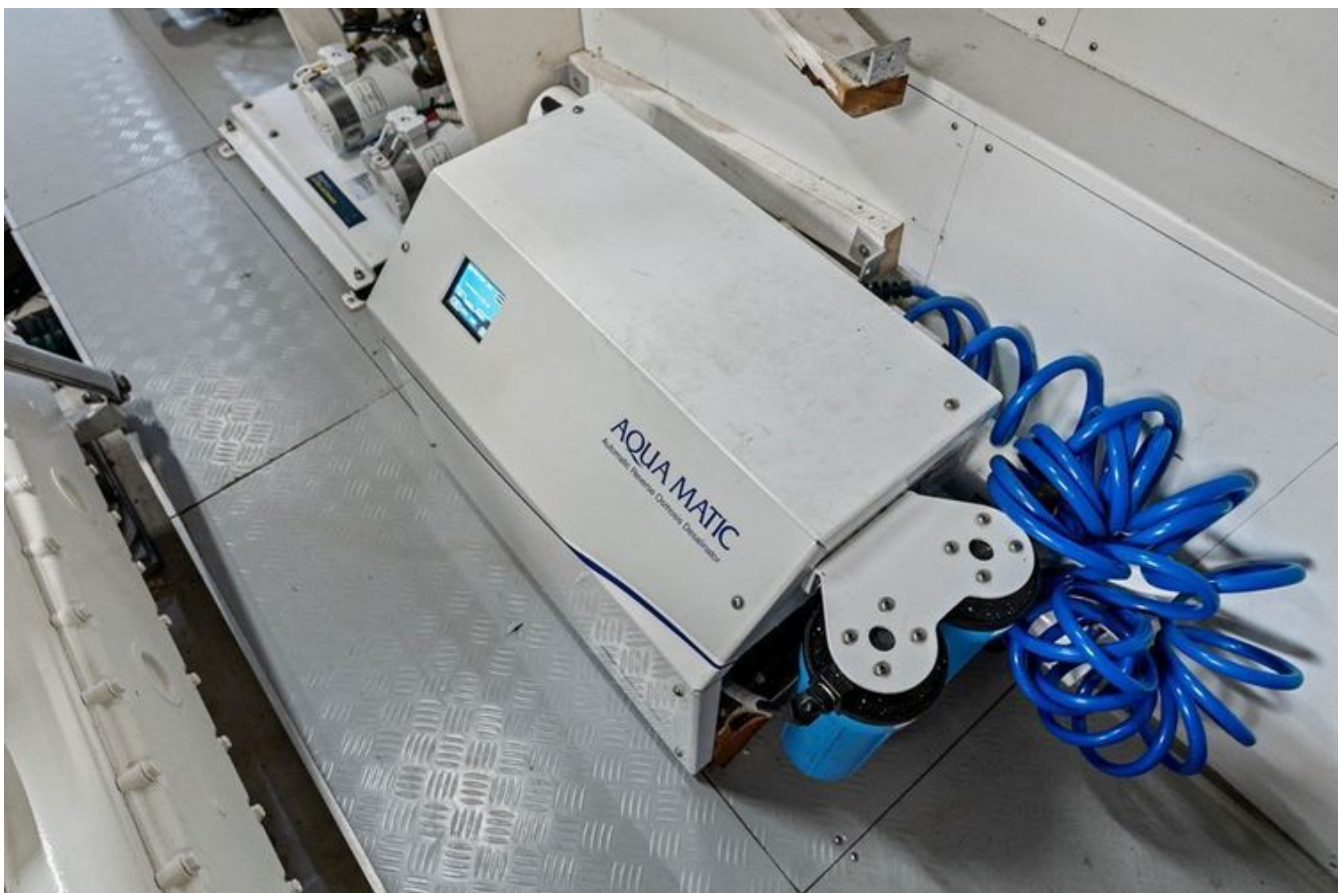

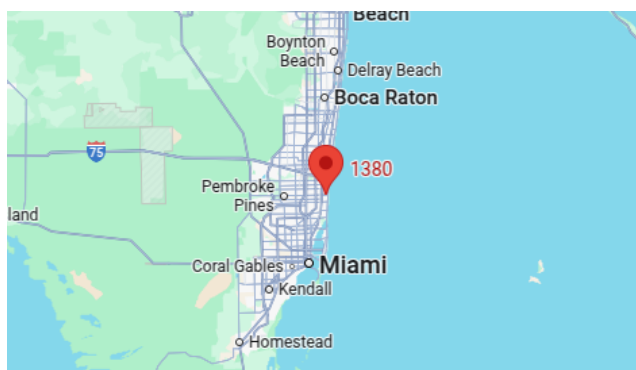
