OVERVIEW

The CRAFT 70 by Ferretti Yachts is a motor yacht constructed on a fiberglass hull. Listed with Shestakov Yacht Sales and brokered by Andrey Shestakov, this 70 ft vessel offers a comfortable cruising pace of 22 kn (25.32 mph) and can reach a top speed of 28 kn (32.22 mph).

Selecting a CRAFT 70

Opt for the CRAFT 70 if you need a 70 ft (21.42 m) yacht featuring an 18 ft (5.57 m) beam and a draft that can be specified between 4.921–5.577 ft (1.5–1.7 m). Powered by twin MTU inboard diesels, and equipped with a 1,320.86 gal fuel tank and 264.17 gal freshwater capacity, it is set up for confident coastal and offshore passages. As a motor yacht built in fiberglass, it appeals to owners who value reliable performance and relatively straightforward upkeep.

Features of the Model

- **Powertrain:** Twin MTU inboard diesel engines provide consistent and trustworthy propulsion.
- **Performance:** Typical cruise speed is 22 kn (25.32 mph) with a top end near 28 kn (32.22 mph).
- **Dimensions:** 70 ft (21.42 m) overall length with an 18 ft (5.57 m) beam for roomy decks and good stability.
- **Draft flexibility:** Configurable draft from 4.921–5.577 ft (1.5–1.7 m) to increase cruising options.
- **Capacities:** Large tanks — 1,320.86 gal fuel and 264.17 gal water — extend time between port calls.
- **Build:** Hull constructed of fiberglass with a fiberglass deck, crafted by Ferretti Yachts.

Q: What is the **LOA** of the CRAFT 70? A: The **LOA** is **70 ft (21.42 m)** with a **beam** of **18 ft (5.57 m)** .

Q: What are the **cruise** and **maximum speeds** ? A: The yacht cruises at **22 kn (25.32 mph)** and reaches a maximum of **28 kn (32.22 mph)** .

Q: What powers the yacht and what is the **fuel type** ? A: It is driven by **2 x MTU Inboard** engines running on **Diesel** , providing dependable thrust.

Q: What is the **draft** range and **hull material** ? A: Draft varies from **4.921–5.577 ft (1.5–1.7 m)** , and the hull is fiberglass.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and charter operators commonly regard the CRAFT 70 from Ferretti Yachts as a versatile flybridge yacht that suits family use and also performs well as a crewed day-charter vessel. Typical arrangements offer four en-suite guest cabins plus separate crew quarters, a generous salon with a formal dining area finished in cherry wood, an expansive flybridge for sun and entertaining, and a sizeable swim platform. These attributes support family cruises and charters accommodating up to eight guests, reflecting the market positioning and practical use of the model.

On passage, actual performance depends on engine selection and refit history. Broker and charter logs often show comfortable cruising between 22–26 knots with top speeds in the 28–32 knot range, though many charter operators prefer economical runs around 10 knots to manage fuel burn. Reviews and listings describe generally smooth sea-keeping; numerous refitted yachts note the addition of Seakeeper gyro-stabilizers to lessen roll both underway and at anchor.

Owner feedback also points to the age of many examples (1997 is a common build year), with twin MTU packages (for instance, 1150 hp units) or Caterpillar 3412s frequently fitted. Recent refits reported in sale files include major overhauls such as turbo and injection-pump work plus upgrades like Seakeeper installations, electrical system renewals, and new watermakers—improvements that add comfort but also raise maintenance

complexity and cost. Some owners have complained about tight service access, saying "You have to dismantle half the interior of a room to access maintenance regular items that fail," so thorough review of surveys and refit documentation is recommended.

Pros and Cons

- Family-friendly 4-cabin layout with separate crew, suitable for private cruising or eight-guest charters.
- Smooth ride, with many examples reporting Seakeeper retrofits that reduce roll underway and at anchor.
- Flexible operating profile: cruise at 22–26 knots or run economically around 10 knots for charter-style days.
- Many examples are 1997-vintage and typically require significant recommissioning or refit.
- Maintenance access can be challenging in places, with owner reports of needing to dismantle interior panels for routine service.
- Added systems from refits (gyro, electrical, watermaker) improve comfort but raise service complexity and cost.

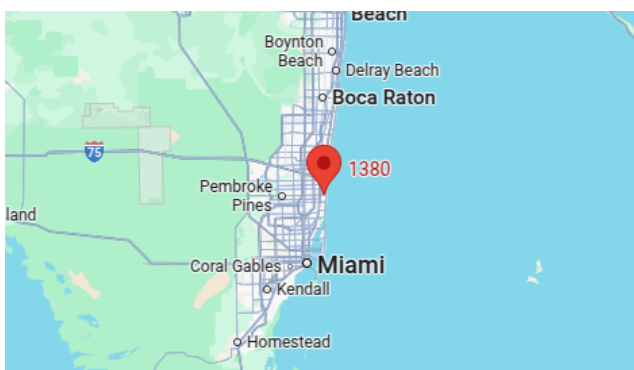
