Selecting a Ferretti 550

Measuring 57 ft (17.42 m) LOA and sporting a 15 ft (4.82 m) beam, the Ferretti 550 strikes a balance between onboard space, handling, and performance. Twin MAN inboard diesels provide a comfortable 25-knot cruise with the ability to reach roughly 30 knots when pushed, while accommodations for up to 6 guests plus dedicated crew quarters accommodate family outings or social weekends. Questions and Answers

- What are the exact dimensions of the Ferretti 550? The **dimensions** are LOA 57 ft (17.42 m), **beam** 15 ft (4.82 m), and **maximum draft** 4.265 ft (1.3 m).
- How fast does it cruise and what is the top speed? The **cruising speed** is 25 knots (28.77 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 30 knots (34.52 mph).
- What powers this yacht? Two **MAN inboard diesel** engines provide propulsion, with **2 engines** in total for dependable performance.
- How many people can sleep aboard, and is there a crew cabin?
Accommodation is for up to 6, plus a **crew area** with 1 cabin and 2 berths.
- What is the build and hull type? It is a motor yacht with a fiberglass hull on a **planing** configuration; the **deck** is **GRP**.

Owner Experience Review

Owners often choose the Ferretti 550 from Ferretti Yachts for its owner-operator appeal, making it well suited to family cruising, day trips, weekend escapes, and coastal runs. The aft galley combined with the seamless salon-to-cockpit circulation and expansive curved glazing creates a welcoming environment for entertaining and keeping guests connected between interior and exterior spaces. Many older hulls are also seen in Mediterranean charter programs, highlighting the layout's adaptability for guests.

On the water the 550 is responsive to throttle inputs, turns with assurance, and maintains steady tracking in 2–3' seas. Real-world reports show a practical cruise range between 20–26 kt: for example, about 20.7 kt at 2000 rpm and roughly 28.7 kt at 2450 rpm, with top speeds reaching the high 20s to approximately 30 kt. Owners can opt for a gyro stabilizer to noticeably reduce roll at anchor and increase onboard comfort.

Below decks, three-stateroom arrangements are typical, anchored by a full beam midships master that benefits from large hull windows and ample storage. The flybridge is relatively compact for this size and sits well aft, and some owners note ergonomic oddities—restricted headroom in certain areas, raised door sills that catch feet, and ceiling-mounted light switches.

Maintenance-wise, engine-room access is praised for its generous working space (owners cite about 21 inches between the Cummins QSM11s on some builds), which simplifies routine servicing; however, a handful of owners have reported intermittent electrical or control issues. Popular extras such as a Seakeeper gyro and H&B electrohydraulic platforms add capability but also increase acquisition and ongoing maintenance costs.

Pros and Cons

- Owner-operator oriented and ideal for family cruising, with a salon-to-cockpit flow that supports entertaining.
- Sharp handling and reliable tracking in 2–3' seas, delivering a comfortable 20–26 kt cruise and near 30 kt top speed in tests.
- Three-stateroom configurations featuring a full beam midships master with generous natural light.
- Flybridge is compact for the segment and positioned well aft compared with some rivals.
- Owners have noted ergonomic issues such as restricted headroom in places, raised door sills, and ceiling-mounted switches.
- A minority of owners report occasional electrical/control faults that need troubleshooting.
