Owner Experience Review

Broker observations and owner feedback consistently describe the Ferretti 850 from Ferretti Yachts as a flexible motoryacht equally at home on private weekend cruises or limited charter work. Owners often cite the four ensuite cabins including a full-beam owner's suite, separate crew accommodations, and the luminous maxiloft open-plan salon as highlights for family use and entertaining. The flybridge and cockpit are regularly commended for practical outdoor living space, and the tender garage converts to a usable swim platform for straightforward sea access.

Underway, the vessel's seakeeping is regarded as strong within its category, and many operators recommend settling into an efficient 8–11 knot cruise for extended passages. With MAN V12 propulsion, anecdotal reports note a 24–26 knot cruise and 29–31 knot maximum in service, with handling that feels stable and assured thanks to the beamy hull form. Owners also mention limited range when running at planing speeds due to relatively modest fuel capacity. In terms of upkeep, the high-gloss exterior demands diligent cosmetic maintenance, MAN engine servicing is best left to authorized technicians with

corresponding parts and labor costs, side or exterior engine-room access simplifies routine work, and larger modifications—such as installing long-range tanks or adding internal staircases—are complex and expensive undertakings.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile layout that suits family cruising and occasional small charter use.
- Bright maxiloft salon and well-used flybridge and cockpit for social time outdoors.
- Confident, stable handling with fast planing performance when desired.
- Range at planing speeds is constrained by relatively small fuel capacity.
- Premium high-gloss finishes require attentive cosmetic upkeep.
- MAN V12 service and parts through certified technicians can be costly.

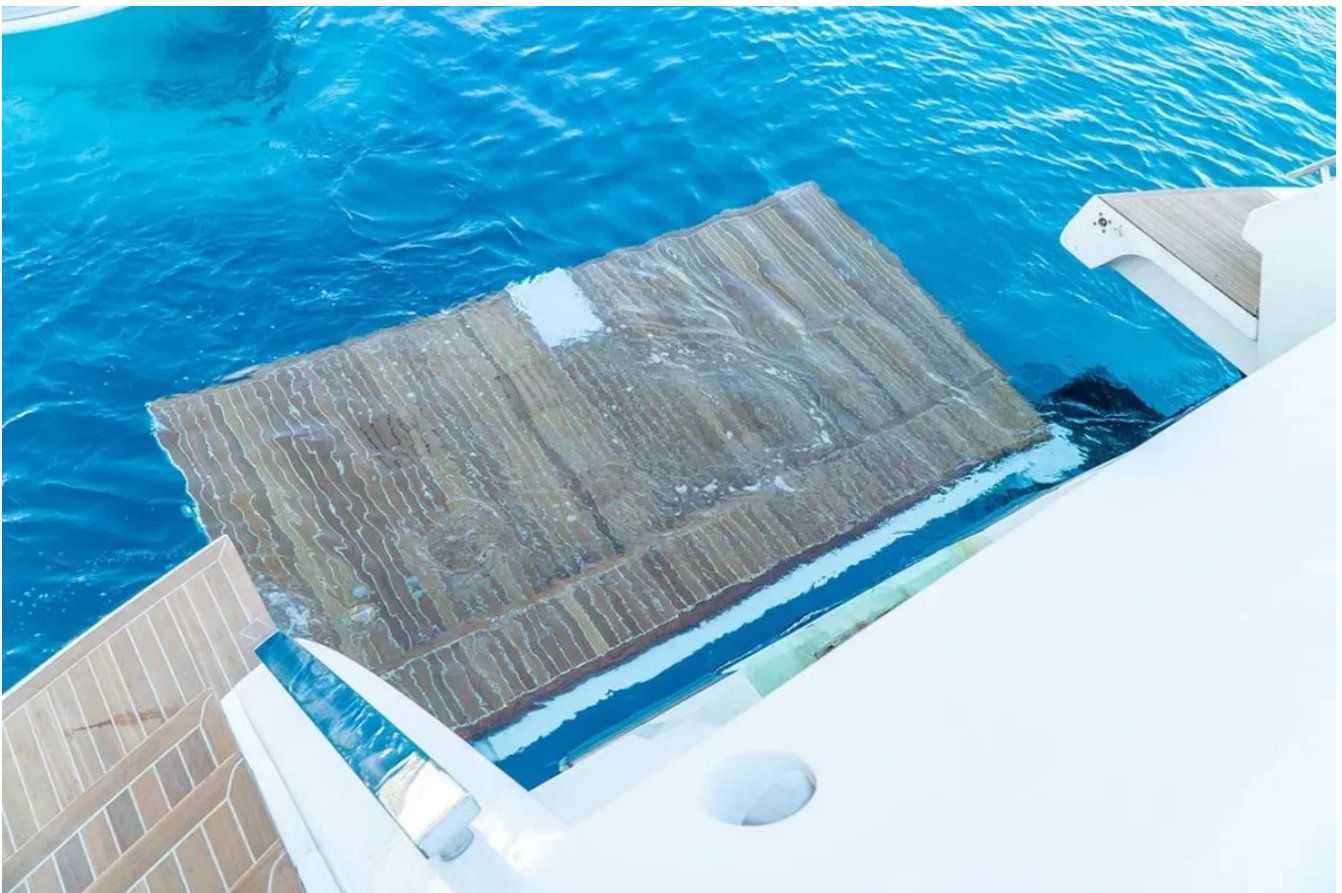

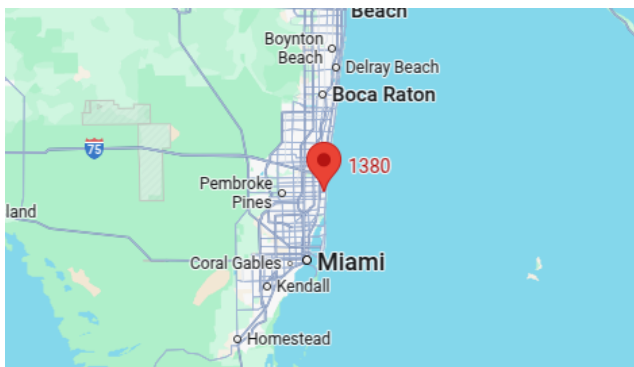
