The 382 Fastech from Formula Boats is a performance-focused motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic planing hull. It cruises comfortably at 35 kn (40.28 mph) and can reach a top speed of 42 kn (48.33 mph). Measuring 38 ft LOA with an 8 ft beam and a shallow 2.953 ft (0.9 m) draft, it's well suited to coastal day trips and short overnight cruises; the planing hull rewards experienced skippers with sharp, responsive handling. Q: What type of yacht is the 382 Fastech? A: Type: The 382 Fastech is a high-performance motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic planing hull and penned by Formula Boats.

Q: How fast does it go? A: Performance: Anticipate a cruising speed around 35 kn (40.28 mph) with a top capability near 42 kn (48.33 mph), enabling brisk, confidence-inspiring passages.

Owner Experience Review

Owners of the Formula Boats 382 Fastech commonly split their time between family day cruises and swift weekend getaways, with many also using the boat for watersports or occasional show and charter duties. Multiple owner reports and test rewrites describe a comfortable, climate-controlled cabin equipped with a refrigerator, sink, and a VacuFlush head—features that make short stays practical—though the single-cabin footprint is noticeably tighter than what larger cruisers offer.

On the water, both owners and test pilots repeatedly applaud the FAS3Tech hull for delivering a soft, forgiving ride in choppy conditions, with the boat's relatively heavier displacement contributing to steady tracking. Conversations among owners often focus on re-propping to find the best speed/handling balance; one owner reported "ran 98 and handled great," while another noted that with optimized props in salt water you can see "close to 90." These remarks are anecdotal and vary with installed power, prop selection, and environmental conditions.

Maintenance threads emphasize attention to Bravo stern drives: recurring reports of failures have prompted owners to recommend proactive, sometimes seasonal, removal and inspection. Several discussions link

high-grip, low-slip propellers (including five-blade options) to increased loading on drives, and a number of owners who experimented with substantial power upgrades later retreated in favor of reliability. The practical conclusion is that keeping engines and drives in good order can become expensive if you constantly push for maximum top speed without a conservative service regimen.

Pros and Cons

- Soft, forgiving ride in chop with stable tracking from the FAS3Tech hull.
- Plush, climate controlled cabin with refrigerator, sink, and VacuFlush supports weekend use.
- Capable performance with owner reported high speeds when propped correctly.
- Heavy displacement and high grip prop choices can stress stern drives over time.
- Bravo outdrives benefit from proactive, sometimes seasonal, removal and inspection.
- Single cabin layout is compact versus larger cruisers and can feel tight on longer stays.
