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OVERVIEW

The 34 Center Console from FOUNTAIN is a high performance motor yacht conceived as a capable sport fisherman with a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull. Propelled by triple Mercury outboards, it offers an invigorating 42 kn cruise and a 75 kn top end for anglers who demand speed and precise handling.

Selecting a 34 Center Console

When your priorities include brisk runs, agile handling and a straightforward, fish focused layout, the 34 Center Console makes a compelling choice. Its 34 ft (10.36 m) LOA and 9 ft (2.9 m) beam strike a balance between blistering performance and a usable cockpit. With a 300 gal fuel reserve and 30 gal of freshwater capacity, it's configured for extended days chasing offshore marks.

Q: What type of yacht is the 34 Center Console? A: It's a motor yacht laid out as a sport fisherman built on a fiberglass and plastic hull by FOUNTAIN. This clear **classification** describes its intended use and capabilities.

Q: How fast does it go? A: The 34 Center Console will achieve a **maximum**

speed of 75 kn (86.31 mph) and typically cruises at about 42 kn (48.33 mph), giving serious **performance** for tournament anglers and performance enthusiasts.

Q: What powers this model? A: It's driven by three Mercury **engines** in an **outboard** arrangement running on **Gas/Petrol**, offering strong acceleration and straightforward access for servicing.

Q: What are the draft details? A: The **draft** measures from a minimum of 6.562 ft (2 m) to a maximum of 8.475 ft (2.5833 m), allowing operation across a range of conditions.

Owner Experience Review

Owners choose the 34 Center Console from FOUNTAIN for two distinct types of outings: offshore tournament runs and relaxed family days. The deck is arranged for productive fishing with multiple rocket launchers and oversized fishboxes, while the bow lounge, soft coaming pads and convertible cockpit seating create a comfortable social area for sandbar stops. As one owner summarized, it's "a pretty nice compromise between speed, fishability and livability."

Performance is a standout attribute. Independent test runs recorded roughly 62 mph with twin 350 Verados and about 64 mph with twin 400s, and owners often praise how quickly the boat covers water between fishing spots. The stepped (double-step/Positive Lift) hull delivers an aggressive hole-shot, efficient cruise characteristics and confident cornering—reviewers noted it tracks well in turns without the spin out issues some stepped hulls can

show—and several forum users describe the 34 as both a “tank and fishing machine.”

Daily usability is enhanced by a protected helm beneath a large hardtop with storage and LED lighting, plus space for large multifunction displays. Anglers benefit from dedicated tackle and rigging lockers, twin livewells and removable bow cushions that sit above cooler space, while access panels under central hatches simplify service tasks. Model lineage is important: the series launched in 2003; early 2003–08 builds used wood stringers/transoms that were later replaced by full composite grids, and many buyers prefer the later composite boats. Pre purchase inspections commonly emphasize lower unit and propeller gearbox condition, and experienced owners recommend confirming actual fuel consumption rather than relying solely on advertised figures.

Pros and Cons

- Serious offshore fishability with a roomy deck, multiple rocket launchers and large fishboxes.
- High-speed capability around 62–64 mph with twin 350–400 Verados and a quick hole-shot from the stepped hull.
- Family-friendly dayboat features including a bow lounge with removable cushions, soft coamings and convertible cockpit seating.
- Early 2003–08 examples may have wood stringers/transoms, while later boats moved to all-composite construction.
- Owners flag lower-unit/propeller gearbox condition as an important pre-purchase inspection item.
- Real-world fuel burn can differ from listings, so buyers commonly verify consumption for their setup.
