OVERVIEW

The 288 Vista offered by FOUR WINNS represents a nimble and adaptable motor yacht in the cruiser category. Built on a proven fiberglass construction hull with a Deep Vee form, it's sized to suit weekend escapes and provides sleeping accommodations for four.

Selecting a 288 Vista

The 288 Vista is well suited to buyers who want a compact footprint without sacrificing confident handling or onboard comfort. Positioned as a family-oriented cruiser, it pairs a 28 ft LOA with a 9 ft beam and typically runs on twin FOUR WINNS-specified Volvo Penta I/O gas powerplants, includes one head, and carries balanced fuel and water capacities appropriate for short coastal cruises. Owner Experience Review

Owners often choose the FOUR WINNS 288 Vista for family-oriented cruising and weekend escapes; the cabin's usable volume and a practical galley make short coastal itineraries straightforward to plan. Overnighting two to four people is a frequent use case, while the cockpit seating and swim platform enhance its appeal as a sociable dayboat. Many owners customize the cockpit with increased shade, additional fender and storage solutions, and upgraded cushions.

When underway the boat presents a steady feel for a sub 30' express; the modified V hull and the wider 9'8" beam add to its predictable, stable motion. Owners report that handling and cruise characteristics depend heavily on the engine and outdrive combination installed, and discussions about alternative power choices and repowers are common—making a full sea trial of the specific vessel essential.

Belowdecks the layout is generous for the size, though taller sailors frequently point out restricted vertical headroom—one long term owner noted only a couple of inches of clearance in the main cabin and needing to stoop in the head. Maintenance histories vary from extended, trouble-free ownership with scheduled servicing to forum conversations about occasional propulsion or fuel system quirks; prospective buyers should carefully inspect fuel and electrical systems, bellows, shaft/prop hardware, impellers, zincs, and bilge pumps/wiring, and take extra care with composite outdrives on certain model years, confirming engine room access and outdrive condition.

Pros and Cons

- Cabin and galley are spacious for the class, supporting family cruising and 2–4 person overnights.
- Modified V hull and 9'8" beam deliver a generally stable, solid feel underway.
- Cockpit layout works well for social dayboating, and owners appreciate the ergonomics.
- Vertical headroom is limited for taller users, especially in the head.
- Ride and cruise performance vary widely by engine/outdrive package, making sea trials critical.
- Some years used composite outdrives and owners note isolated fuel/electrical quirks, so pre purchase inspection is essential.

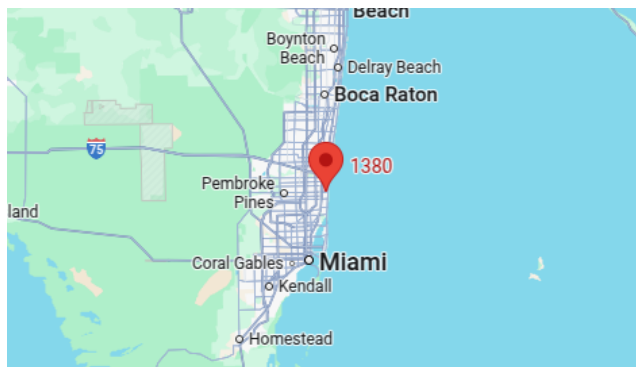
