OVERVIEW

Discover the 348 by FOUR WINNS — a motor yacht designed as an adaptable cruiser built from durable fiberglass and plastic. Listed by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, this model combines assured performance with practical onboard comforts ideal for extended weekends afloat.

Selecting a 348

If your goal is a maneuverable yet capable platform for short coastal runs and overnight trips, the 348 makes an attractive option. It cruises comfortably at 25 kn (28.77 mph) and can reach a maximum of 33 kn (37.98 mph), giving brisk transit for a motor yacht in the cruiser class. Measuring 35 ft (10.67 m) overall with a 12 ft (3.66 m) beam, the hull provides a stable footprint suited to family or couple cruising, while accommodations for four and a single head keep life aboard straightforward. Be aware of the fixed draft of 3.0 m (9.843 ft) when planning marinas and cruising areas.

Features of the Model

- A performance-minded hull plan propelled by twin Volvo engines (2 engines) for assured acceleration and economical cruising.
- Robust fiberglass and plastic construction featuring a fiberglass deck and conventional monohull design.
- A functional interior layout with sleeping space for 4 and one head, optimized for uncomplicated weekend voyages.
- Generous fuel capacity of 230 gal to enable longer day runs, and a 40 gal freshwater reserve suitable for short cruises.
- In-house design and finishing by FOUR WINNS ensuring engineering and interior appointments are executed under one roof.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 348? A: It's a motor yacht marketed as a versatile cruiser built on a durable fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: How fast does it go? A: The 348 delivers a **cruising speed** of 25 kn (28.77 mph) and a **top speed** of 33 kn (37.98 mph).

Q: How many people can it sleep? A: The interior provides **accommodations** for 4, **sleeps** 4, and includes 1 head for convenience onboard.

Q: What powers the boat? A: Twin **Volvo** powerplants — specifically **2 engines** — provide dependable propulsion and handling.

Q: What are the tank capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 230 gal to support extended day runs, and **water capacity** is 40 gal appropriate for short-stay cruising.

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically employ the 348 by FOUR WINNS for family outings, weekend overnights, and lively cockpit gatherings, with several stretching their trips into multi-day coastal passages thanks to on-board generator and air-conditioning installations. The interior plan — a forward V-berth, a convertible aft berth, a full galley, and a VacuFlush head — suits couples or small families well, and cockpit seating plus storage frequently earn positive remarks. At least one owner has noted the cabin finish feels superior to comparable Sea Ray layouts.

Reports from time on the water emphasize steady handling, a solid cruising pace, and a composed, confident ride in chop. Typical cruise is cited near 28 knots, and a number of owners liken the ride quality favorably against similar Sea Ray models.

Maintenance commentary is varied. There are recorded instances of engine failures on some boats, including catastrophic connecting-rod failures necessitating long-block replacements or rebuilds, alongside raw-water/cooling concerns such as impeller contamination, a burst hose between the thermostat housing and water circulator, and routine exhaust riser/manifold

maintenance. While engine access via an electric hatch eases some work, some owners have faced expensive rebuilds and difficulty locating reman Crusader 6.0 blocks; conversely, one owner reports a 2005 boat equipped with 6.0 Crusaders and about 700 hours operating well when diligently maintained. Several owners have chosen to upgrade or replace engines (for example, installing Crusader 6.0 units) after encountering power or repair issues.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile for family cruising, weekend overnights, and entertaining in the cockpit.
- Comfortable cabin layout with a V-berth, convertible aft berth, full galley, and a VacuFlush head.
- Smooth, assured ride with a typical cruise around 28 knots.
- Some boats have documented engine failures, including catastrophic long-block issues.
- Reported raw-water cooling problems such as impeller debris and burst coolant hoses.
- Costly rebuilds and limited availability of reman Crusader 6.0 blocks have been cited by owners.

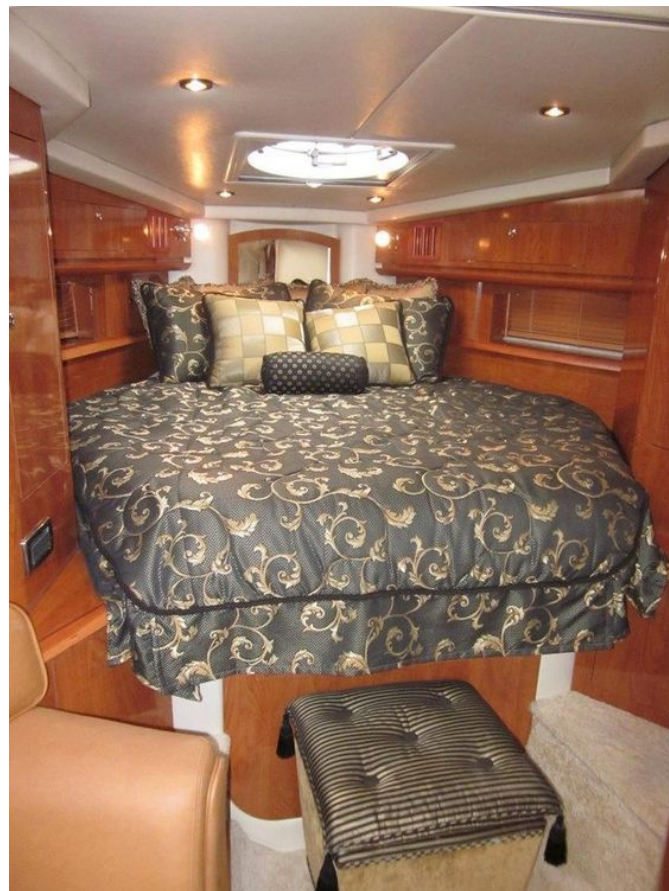
