The H6C from FOUR WINNS is a refined, dayboat class motor yacht built on a reliable fiberglass and plastic hull and driven by a single Mercury outboard. Marketed globally by Shestakov Yacht Sales, it pairs compact overall dimensions with practical performance, making it well suited to easy coastal cruising and active days on the water. With a single Mercury outboard and an efficient hull form, this boat fits buyers who want a flexible platform for day trips, entertaining at anchorages, and family outings on lakes or along the coast.

Q: What are the key dimensions I should know? A: **Dimensions** are 26 ft (7.98 m) LOA, an 8 ft (2.56 m) beam, and a maximum draft of 10.663 ft (3.25 m).

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers generally view the H6C as a sociable, 26-foot bowrider that performs well for family days and extended lounging. The cockpit arrangement receives frequent praise—an L-shaped seat, inviting bow seating, and practical walkthroughs (including an extra starboard passage) that simplify boarding, line handling, and moving about when the boat is fully crewed. Rated for as many as 11 passengers, many users see the layout as adaptable for high-occupancy day use or light charter and rental scenarios. The H Series debuted in 2022, and the H6C has surfaced in 2025–2026 dealer inventories, meaning the long-term owner feedback is still developing.

On the water, the deep-V hull with roughly 18° of deadrise provides a composed, refined ride for a bowrider in typical lake and coastal conditions, and handling is commonly described as steady and predictable. Performance varies with engine selection: industry observers often recommend a 350 hp outboard for brisk acceleration, towing and watersports with a full load, whereas a 250 hp installation will perform adequately with lighter loads but may feel underpowered when heavily loaded or when pulling skiers.

Comfort aboard emphasizes useful, owner-friendly details—convertible aft

lounging, ample under seat storage, a built in stereo, wireless phone charging, and back lit control switches. Owners have singled out the seating configuration and cushion quality for positive comment, and inboard versions use engine space to free up additional dry storage. Feedback from broader FOUR WINNS owner communities is mixed: some report challenges with warranty servicing and dealer interactions, and there are notes of cosmetic hardware pitting on older examples. Community guidance also highlights that sterndrive boats typically demand more frequent maintenance than outboard models, so prospective buyers of used boats should arrange comprehensive engine diagnostics and a full survey.

Pros and Cons

- Generous social cockpit and bow seating with an L shaped arrangement that can accommodate up to 11 people.
- Deep V hull (~18°) yields predictable handling and a comfortable ride in common lake and coastal conditions.
- Thoughtful onboard amenities and storage, including an integrated stereo, wireless charging, and roomy under seat compartments.
- 250 hp configurations can feel underpowered when the boat is fully loaded or when towing; 350 hp is recommended for watersports and stronger performance.
- Reports of warranty and dealer service friction at FOUR WINNS suggest buyers should establish clear service plans.
- Some owners of older FOUR WINNS models have experienced hardware pitting or corrosion, so inspect fittings and finishes carefully.

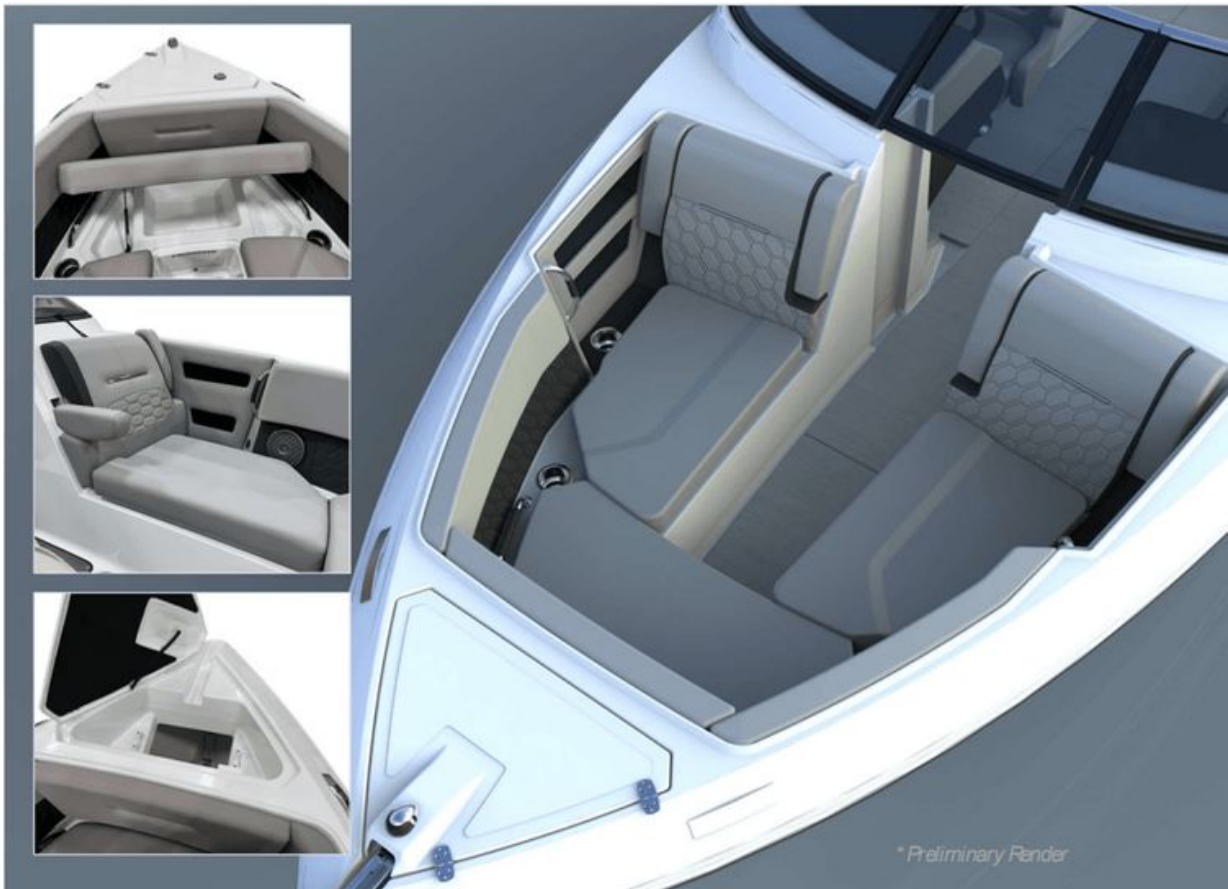

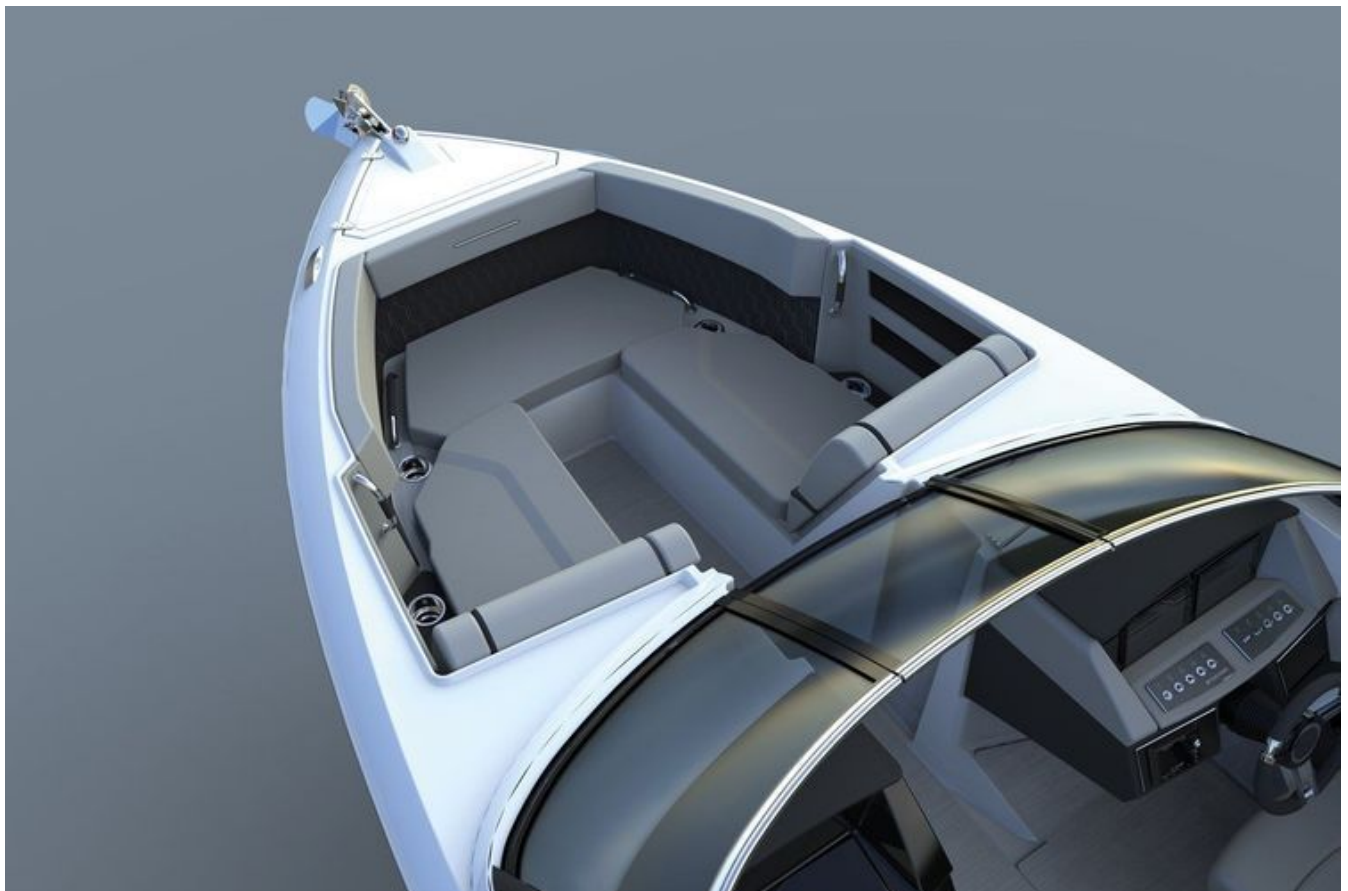
