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OVERVIEW

Introducing the adaptable HD3 from FOUR WINNS, a contemporary motor yacht constructed with durable fiberglass and plastic materials, represented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Selecting a HD3

Picking the correct 22-foot dayboat is about matching the boat's layout and capabilities to your needs. The HD3 combines a 22 ft (6.73 m) LOA and an 8 ft (2.56 m) beam with a single Mercury outboard designed to run on gas/petrol. Onboard amenities include a single head, fiberglass deck surfaces, and tankage aimed at day cruising: 44 gal of fuel and 12 gal of fresh water.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly describe the HD3 from FOUR WINNS as a family-oriented day boat—essentially a 22' hybrid deck boat ideal for inland lakes and relaxed weekend cruises. The social-focused layout receives praise: a spacious U-shaped cockpit seating up to 12, a convertible table with a bow filler, and an enclosed head/changing room that many owners deem indispensable. Reviews also note upscale touches like hand-stitched upholstery, a convertible aft sun lounge, and abundant under-seat storage that balance comfort with practicality.

On the water, the Stable Vee modified V-hull delivers steady on station stability and handling familiar to those used to bowriders. With recommended I/O power, owners report brisk planning performance—one owner specifically cites a Bravo 3 Merc 250 installation that “gets on plane fast and [is] very reliable.” For wake sports, the optional Surf package, which includes ballast and wake-shaping tabs, allows crews to tune and shape wakes on the Surf variant.

Overall owner feedback trends positive: one user reports “no problems in the 3 years I have owned it.” That said, routine care for I/O drives is important—forums warn about potential electrolysis/corrosion if boats remain in the water for extended periods—and many buyers weigh local dealer service coverage when selecting engines. Manufacturer warranty and dealer support are mentioned favorably, and wide-ranging searches have not revealed recurring, model-specific factory defects; most owner conversations center on engine choice and normal I/O maintenance.

Pros and Cons

- Family-oriented layout with a U-shaped cockpit, seating for up to 12, and an enclosed head/changing room.
- Stable Vee hull combined with suitable I/O power produces quick planing and familiar bowrider-like handling.
- Optional Surf package provides ballast and wake shaping tabs for adjustable, rideable wakes.
- I/O drives are susceptible to corrosion/electrolysis if the boat is left in the water, requiring diligent maintenance or dry storage.
- Local dealer and service network availability may influence engine selection, so verify support before purchase.
- Key amenities and watersports options are dependent on factory or dealer-installed packages, so not every HD3 will include an enclosed head or Surf equipment.

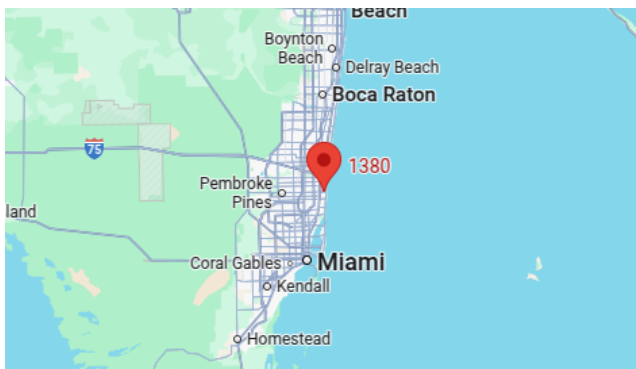
