Owner Experience Review

Owners regularly push the 47 from Freeman Boatworks hard offshore for tournament schedules, high-end charters in the Southeast, and relaxed family or weekend outings. The common theme in feedback is confidence in offshore conditions, with many praising a composed, steady ride and comments such as "She rides like a dream!".

Typical cruising figures cited in owner reports and spec listings are often in the mid 40s mph, with the potential for higher top-end speeds on lighter loads depending on engine choices. Onboard, users find the helm and deck genuinely spacious for crew and gear, with large, well-placed storage and tackle solutions. Owners also note tidy wiring and installation spaces—"so much room and so organized"—which makes adding electronics or future upgrades straightforward.

Everyday ownership is pragmatic: parts and factory support come directly from Freeman Boatworks, while owners commonly turn to Facebook groups and forums for hard-to-find parts or peer advice. There's no recurring, model-wide defect trend in community discussions, though a few older boats have cosmetic issues such as paint fade; high performance outboard setups do increase service and parts expenses. Prospective buyers should also budget for long build lead times—owners report 2–4 year waits and sizable deposits

for new orders.

- Smooth, stable ride that inspires confidence offshore.
- Typical cruise in the mid 40s mph, with potential for higher speeds depending on engines and load.
- Roomy helm and deck, abundant storage, and organized wiring that makes installs and upgrades easier.
