The 55 LS Flybridge from Galeon Yachts is a multi-purpose motor yacht constructed with a fiberglass and plastic yacht hull. Powered by twin inboard diesel units and equipped with practical tankage, it's designed for confident coastal passages with family and friends.

With an overall length of 58 ft (17.7 m) and a beam of 15 ft (4.7 m), the model delivers ample interior volume, while a maximum draft of 15.037 ft (4.5833 m) signals a substantial, ocean-capable profile. Twin Volvo Penta inboard diesel engines provide the kind of propulsion package suited to extended coastal cruising.

Q: What powers the 55 LS Flybridge? A: It is fitted with two **Volvo Penta** engines configured as **Inboard** units running on **diesel** .

Q: What are the key dimensions of the yacht? A: The yacht measures **58 ft (17.7 m)** LOA, has a beam of **15 ft (4.7 m)** , and a maximum draft of **15.037 ft (4.5833 m)** .

Q: Is this a motor yacht and what is the hull type? A: Yes — it is a motor yacht featuring a fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What are the onboard capacities and accommodations? A: The vessel carries **581 gal** of fuel and **185 gal** of freshwater, and is fitted with **2 heads** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners often choose the 55 LS Flybridge from Galeon Yachts as an adaptable family weekender or an entertaining dayboat. In everyday use it's frequently handled by a couple with two to four guests aboard; the flybridge, split-level cockpit, and fold-down bulwark provide a versatile deck arrangement ideal for socializing. Interiors benefit from abundant natural light and a feeling of space that rivals larger 55-foot designs, with full-beam owner stateroom configurations being a commonly praised feature.

Underway, owners describe the hull as notably sea-kindly, with a comparatively low center of gravity that helps the yacht remain steady in short chop. Typical cruising speeds reported fall in the mid-20-knot band (roughly 22–28 knots), and handling is complimented for being responsive whether using joystick/assisted docking systems or more traditional shaft/IPS setups. One owner summed up their satisfaction succinctly: "I love my Yacht Controller and would not buy another yacht without one!"

Maintenance commentary is practical rather than effusive. Hydraulic

components that operate the folding bulwarks, doors, and sunroofs are mentioned repeatedly as items that need attention, so a well-documented service history is important. Outside Europe, sourcing parts and locating technicians with the necessary expertise can take longer, and warranty handling differs by dealer. Routine engine-room access is generally rated as acceptable, but long-term upkeep costs will vary based on the engine choice (Volvo or MAN).

Pros and Cons

- Sea-kindly behavior with a relatively low center of gravity that helps the yacht remain composed in choppy conditions.
- Comfortable cruising in the mid 20 knot range (about 22–28 knots) with agile handling and support for joystick/assisted docking.
- Bright, spacious interior and sociable layout featuring a flybridge, split-level cockpit, and fold-down bulwark.
- Hydraulic systems for folding bulwarks, doors, and sunroofs are recurring service items; verify maintenance records.
- Outside Europe, parts and specialist service can be slow to arrange, and warranty experiences vary by dealer.
- Some owners find the flybridge cover to be a minor nuisance.

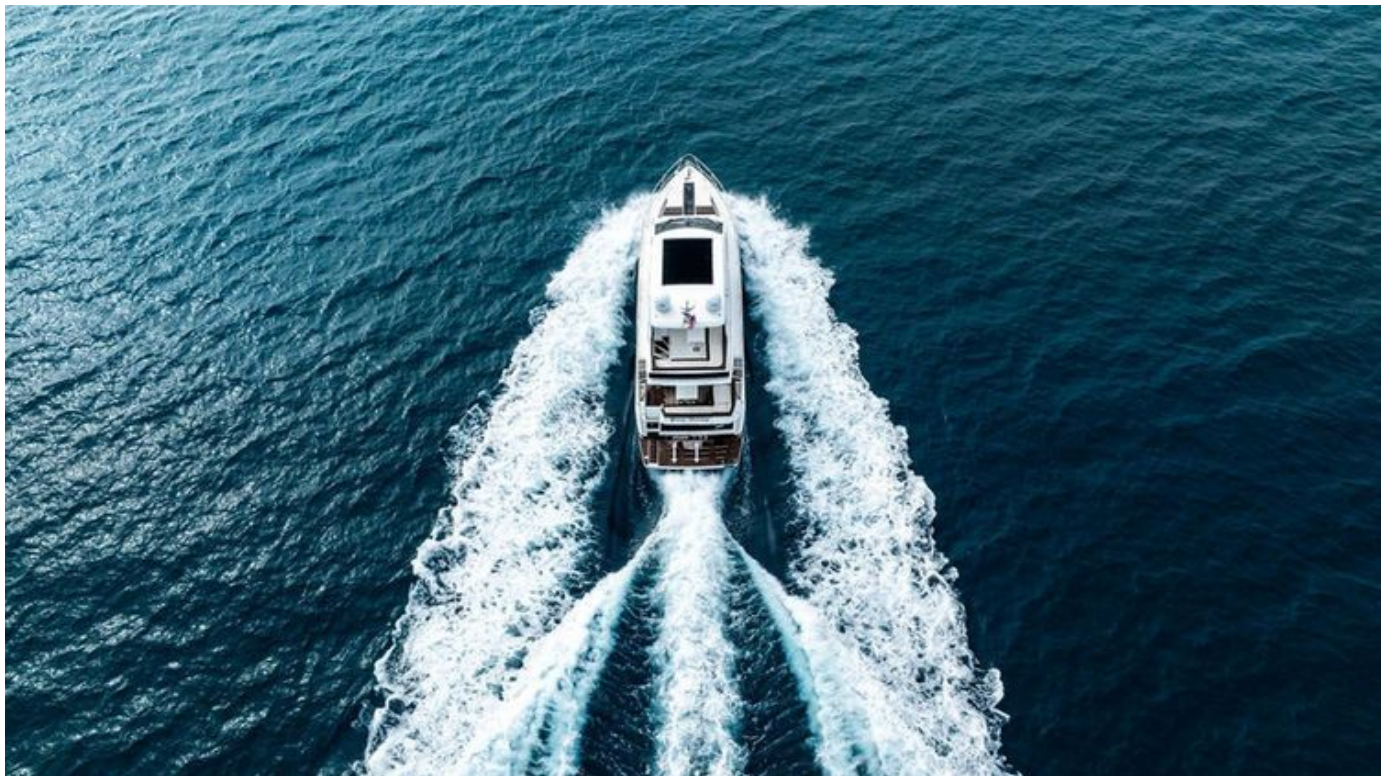
