# OVERVIEW

---

Crafted by Galeon Yachts, the 640 Fly is a motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic hull. Marketed through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this flybridge yacht is aimed at owners who want well-proportioned accommodation, dependable twin diesel inboard performance, and carefully considered onboard comforts.

---

## Selecting a 640 Fly

---

Opting for the 640 Fly is a strong choice when you want the living area and presence of a roughly 68-foot yacht combined with the elevated helm and social spaces a flybridge provides, all powered by twin inboard diesels. Its 16 ft beam delivers substantial interior volume and, together with the pronounced draft, supports stable behavior underway and generous fuel and water stowage for extended cruising. As a motor yacht constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull, it balances structural resilience with onboard comfort for coastal passages or longer voyages.

- Q: What type of yacht is the 640 Fly? A: It's a motor yacht produced by Galeon Yachts and built on a fiberglass and plastic hull.

- Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The **LOA** measures 68 ft (20.8 m), the **beam** is 16 ft (5 m), and the **draft** is 15.857 ft (4.8333 m).
- Q: What powers the yacht? A: It is driven by two **Volvo Penta** units in an **Inboard** arrangement running on **Diesel** .
- Q: What onboard capacities support longer trips? A: The yacht carries **950 gal** of fuel and **210 gal** of freshwater, and includes **3 heads** to enhance comfort on extended passages.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners often select the 640 Fly from Galeon Yachts because it functions brilliantly as a social platform: the expansive cockpit, powered fold-down side balconies and a roomy flybridge make entertaining straightforward. For short breaks, the tender garage and hi-lo swim platform convert the yacht into a versatile watersports base, and many examples include a dedicated crew cabin with separate access that works well for charter operations or fully crewed ownership. Its design intent is clearly family coastal cruising and longer trips, with reviewers noting a polished cruising character.

On passage, owners report top speeds in the 30–34-knot range depending on engine specification, with handling described as composed for a vessel in the 64–68-foot class. The deep-V hull shows good capability in choppy conditions, and Seakeeper gyros are frequently fitted to reduce roll both at anchor and underway. It's worth noting the Beach Mode bulwarks expand usable deck area when at rest rather than improving seakeeping underway.

Daily-life details earn praise: the aft galley is consistently commended for its large work surfaces and storage, the walkthrough windscreen is highlighted as

a clever ergonomic feature, and overall fit-and-finish receives high marks. Practical access is mostly well thought through—engine-room entry via a full-height watertight door gives ample headroom and reach to systems such as the generator and filters—but battery compartments can be awkward to service, some boats are set up with only a single primary fuel filter per engine, and popular extras like Seakeeper or YachtController introduce further maintenance items and lifecycle costs.

## Pros and Cons

- Expansive social zones including powered fold-down side balconies, a large cockpit and a substantial flybridge make this model ideal for entertaining.
- The deep-V hull delivers a refined ride, and the frequently specified Seakeeper option helps minimize roll at anchor and underway.
- Aft galley design provides generous counter space and storage, build quality is strong, and layouts are flexible with 3–4 cabin arrangements plus separate crew access.
- Battery access is limited, which can complicate replacement and routine service.
- Several configurations rely on a single primary fuel filter per engine, a setup that owners and reviewers often criticize.
- Optional systems such as Seakeeper and YachtController add complexity to maintenance and increase ongoing ownership costs.
