OVERVIEW

The 26 by GAUSE BUILT BOATS is a compact, capable motor yacht designed around a practical center console layout and a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull. Shestakov Yacht Sales, represented by broker Andrey Shestakov, is available to assist with selecting and purchasing this model.

Selecting a 26

Selecting the 26 means choosing a well-balanced 26 ft (7.92 m) platform with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam, driven by a single Yamaha outboard on gas. Constructed by GAUSE BUILT BOATS, it appeals to buyers who want a no-nonsense center console configuration within the motor yacht category and a hull listed under fiberglass and plastic. Owner Experience Review

Owners report using the 26 from GAUSE BUILT BOATS in diverse environments, from shallow flats and protected bays to short offshore runs. In choppy conditions it is frequently praised for providing a dry, quiet ride and handling characteristics that many liken to a larger sportfisher. Some owners have comfortably run 60+ miles offshore in good weather, although at least one commentator claims it “does not live up to the hype,” highlighting the value of a full sea trial and realistic expectations.

Aboard, the layout aims to serve both anglers and families. Owners note plentiful dry storage—often more than comparable boats—along with comfort upgrades such as full cushion sets, forward dodgers/tops, and optional upper station Biminis. Fundamentally a center console day boat, it is intended for day use and weekend getaways rather than extended liveaboard cruising, while retaining fishing functionality through wide gunwales, dedicated tackle space, and the ability to fit towers or upper stations.

Over time, owners commonly schedule factory servicing, cosmetic refreshes, repowers, and electronics modernizations as part of regular upkeep. GAUSE BUILT BOATS has a reputation for attentive service—including pick up/delivery—and marketplace searches and forum threads do not indicate systemic hull or mechanical failures; most negative comments tend to reflect individual performance expectations rather than chronic defects.

Pros and Cons

- Runs in very shallow water (reported under 1 ft) yet delivers a dry, quiet ride in bay chop.
- Confident handling that many compare to a larger sportfisher, with redesigns credited for increased stiffness and a smoother motion.

- Generous dry storage and family oriented options (cushions, shade, upper station) while remaining a serious fishing platform.
- Center console day boat layout limits cabin space and therefore overnighting and liveboard capability.
- Best suited to light offshore day trips rather than long range passages or heavy weather.
- Long term ownership often includes repowers and electronics upgrades, so budgeting for periodic updates is advisable.
