OVERVIEW

Meet the 295 Hinckley Style Picnic from GORBON — an attractively compact motor yacht inspired by classic picnic boat proportions, placed among nimble cruisers and constructed using low maintenance fiberglass and plastic construction. Shestakov Yacht Sales lists this traditional dayboat with brokerage support led by Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a 295 Hinckley Style Picnic

If you prize elegant, traditional lines paired with straightforward ownership and reliable diesel propulsion, the 295 Hinckley Style Picnic is worth considering. At an overall length of 29 ft (8.89 m) and a 9 ft (2.99 m) beam, it's tailored for relaxed harbor cruising and short coastal hops. A single Yanmar inboard diesel keeps systems simple, while the monohull form and a cruising pace around 19 knots (21.86 mph) make day runs efficient. The layout supports two people, includes a dedicated head, and a compact freshwater arrangement that suits brief overnights and extended daytime excursions.

Features of the Model

- Design pedigree: hull by the GORDON Design Team; monohull lines delivering predictable, traditional handling.
- Construction: robust fiberglass and plastic build with a fiberglass deck designed for minimal upkeep.
- Power and performance: single Yanmar inboard diesel; comfortable 19 knot cruise for confident coastal passages.
- Comfort aboard: provisioned for 2 persons, with 1 dedicated berth and 1 head to cover the essentials while underway.
- Capacities tailored to day boating: fuel capacity of 40 gal and freshwater

capacity of 13 gal.

Questions and Answers

Q: What category does the 295 Hinckley Style Picnic belong to? A: It is classed

as a compact motor yacht within the cruiser class, constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: Who builds this model and who designed the hull? A: The builder is GORBON, with the hull penned by the GORDON Design Team.

Q: What is the propulsion setup and typical cruising speed? A: Propulsion comes from a single **Yanmar inboard diesel** , with a reported cruising speed of **19 knots** (21.86 mph).

Q: How is the interior arranged for short trips? A: The interior provides **accommodations for 2** , featuring **1 berth** and **1 head** , making it well suited to day sorties and occasional overnight stays.

Q: What are the principal dimensions and capacities? A: LOA **29 ft (8.89 m)** , beam **9 ft (2.99 m)** , draft **5.906–10.499 ft (1.8–3.2 m)** , fuel **40 gal** , and fresh water **13 gal** . For detailed specifications and purchase support, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Owner Experience Review

Owners often choose the 295 Hinckley Style Picnic by GORBON as a family dayboat and a striking showpiece in marina settings. The cockpit receives frequent acclaim for its roomy layout, making it ideal for on water picnics and casual cruising, while the Hinckley inspired silhouette consistently attracts attention along the docks.

Underway, listings and owners describe the boat as a composed, smooth day cruiser with a planted feel in typical coastal chop. One broker note references an economical cruise near 21 knots consuming about 5 gph when equipped with a 240 hp Yanmar; multiple sources repeat the observation that the styling “turns heads,” though actual performance depends on specific installations and overall condition.

Below deck, livability is purposefully compact: a single cabin, a small galley, and conservative tankage (often cited as 13 gallons fresh water and approximately 25 gallons holding) make it better suited to day trips and short weekend escapes than extended passages. Finish work and classic wood brightwork are commonly praised, but they demand attentive upkeep: examples on the market list Awlgrip hull repaints and brightwork stripped to bare wood and revarnished. Service items noted in listings include a new turbocharger, a Sidewinder stern thruster, a Clarion stereo, a Horizon VHF, and a ProMariner charger. Construction is reported as fiberglass with a carbon/kevlar skin in some examples, and many boats for sale display a professional maintenance history; most of the available feedback is drawn from broker listings rather than long term owner logs.

Pros and Cons

- The cockpit is generously proportioned, making it excellent for picnics and socializing with family and guests.
- The ride is smooth and steady, with confident handling and Hinckley style lines that attract attention.
- Broker listings report approximately a 21 knot cruise at around 5 gph when equipped with a 240 hp Yanmar.
- Restricted below deck volume and modest tankage (about 13 gal fresh and 25 gal holding) limit extended cruising potential.
- Brightwork and varnished wood require continual care to preserve their appearance.
- Performance figures and onboard equipment differ by individual installation, and most published information comes from broker listings rather than standardized sea trials.
