## Owner Experience Review

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Owners favor the 230 Fisherman from Grady-White Boats for both serious offshore and nearshore fishing thanks to its center-console design, spacious cockpit, and dedicated livewell. Many also use the same 23' hull as a trailerable

dayboat for family outings, watersports, and weekend trips because of forward seating with twin insulated fish boxes and an integrated cooler, a continuous single-level deck that keeps the bow area accessible, and a fold-down aft bench that frees up cockpit space when required.

On the water, the SeaV<sup>2</sup> hull is often praised for predictable handling and a smooth, dry ride through head seas. With a single Yamaha 300 being a common test setup, owners and reviewers report a composed, nimble feel and recorded speeds roughly 47–48 mph at wide open throttle, around ~27–30 mph for an easy cruise, and about ~36–37 mph at a brisk cruise.

Comfort and maintenance reflect deliberate design choices, though some practical drawbacks appear in real-world use: the stand-up head housed inside the console features a vinyl liner that is easy to clean, and locating the batteries in the console helps keep them dry and away from the bilge. Conversely, accessing those batteries requires removing screws and a panel, which reviewers find cumbersome. On owner forums, complaints include a swim-platform ladder that seized from rust (with a replacement showing similar problems) and instances of canvas and hardware corrosion, even as professionals continue to note the vessel's solid build with a hand-laid hull and self-bailing deck. The single-outboard configuration simplifies servicing compared with twin-engine setups, and Yamaha F250–F300 powerplants enjoy broad support.

## Pros and Cons

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- SeaV<sup>2</sup> hull delivers a predictable, dry, and stable ride with smooth handling in a head sea.
- Versatile layout supports offshore/nearshore fishing and family day use with forward seating, large cockpit, and an integrated cooler.
- Single-outboard setup (commonly Yamaha F250–F300) simplifies

maintenance and service access.

- Battery removal from the console requires taking out screws/panels and is inconvenient.
- Owners have reported a swim-platform ladder that rusted shut and recurring hardware corrosion.
- Some owners cite canvas quality and wear issues over time.

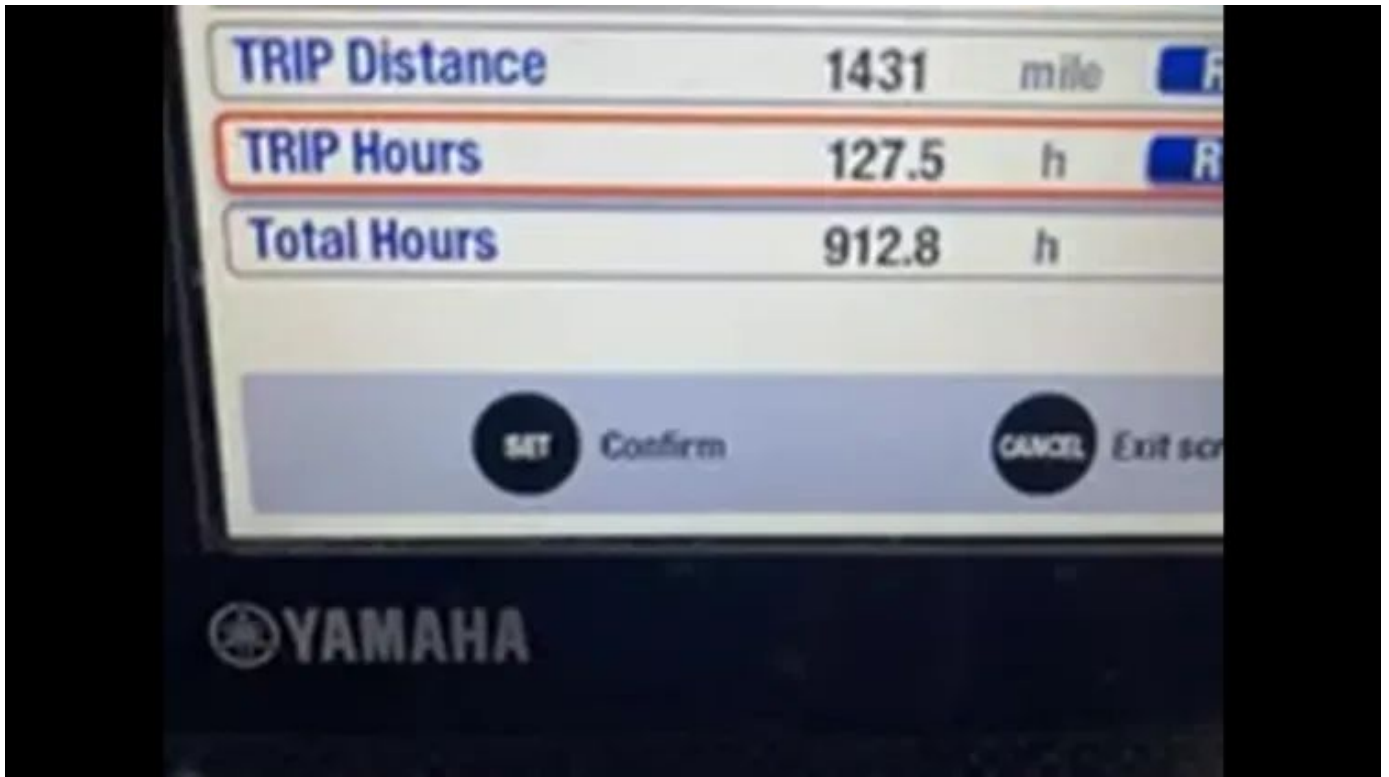
