## OVERVIEW

---

The Chase 273 from Grady-White Boats is a multi-role motor yacht set up as a capable cruiser and built with durable fiberglass and plastic. Listed and marketed by Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team, it offers reassuring offshore capability for spirited day trips and extended runs.

### Selecting a Chase 273

---

Opting for the Chase 273 means choosing a vessel that emphasizes dependable performance, straightforward systems, and low maintenance construction. At 27 ft (8.31 m) LOA with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam, it strikes a balance between being trailer-friendly and providing on-water steadiness. Twin Yamaha outboards deliver lively handling and brisk acceleration, while a 205-gallon fuel tank gives the range to sustain a comfortable 30-kn cruise. For buyers wanting a compact cruiser that behaves like a larger motor yacht, this model is a strong candidate.

- Performance-oriented hull built in fiberglass and plastic to provide strength and reduce upkeep
- Twin Yamaha outboards for dependable propulsion and easy engine access for service
- 30 kn cruising with up to 40 kn top speed for efficient point-to-point transit
- Generous 205 gal fuel capacity to widen cruising possibilities
- Fiberglass deck surfaces for durability and simplified cleaning
- Narrower beam (8 ft / 2.59 m) to ease docking and trailering logistics

## Questions and Answers

---

- What sets the Chase 273 apart? The pairing of twin Yamaha outboards with a robust fiberglass and plastic hull and a compact 27 ft footprint produces assured handling, a steady 30 **kn cruise speed** , and a reachable 40 **kn top speed** .
- Is it suitable for shallow or nearshore waters? With a maximum **draft** of 4.101 ft (1.25 m), the Chase 273 handles nearshore routes well and can be operated carefully in shallower zones typical for a nimble cruiser.

- What engines does it use and what fuel type? The boat is equipped with 2 x **Yamaha outboard** engines that run on **Gas/Petrol** , simplifying maintenance and preserving cockpit and deck space.
- How far can I cruise at speed? A 205 gal **fuel capacity** supports extended range when maintaining a 30 kts **cruise** , helped by the lightweight fiberglass and plastic construction that improves efficiency.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners of the Chase 273 from Grady-White Boats commonly deploy the boat for offshore angling and family day cruises, frequently describing the ride as "very balanced, not a go fast boat but comfortable and very sea worthy." The pronounced deep V hull and fine entry carve through chop, delivering a soft, stable ride that owners trust during bluewater runs; several note it "also raises fish."

The onboard layout supports mixed activities: uncluttered decks with broad walkways, a leaning post, transom livewell and fishboxes, plus a foldaway stern seat make the vessel equally suited to fishing and family use. The console head is compact yet practical, and many owners find it roomy for a boat of this length. While day charters and brief overnights are workable, accommodations are modest for anything beyond short stays.

Performance is designed for balance rather than outright speed; with Yamaha 225s, published figures place top speed near 45 knots, but owners stress that comfortable cruise performance and range are the priorities. In terms of maintenance, owners regularly recommend checking console wiring and fuse panels for tidiness or upgrades, monitoring corrosion on sending units and

fuel/shore connections, and being aware that older Yamaha 4 stroke engines may require mid life servicing or eventual repower.

## Pros and Cons

- Soft, stable offshore ride thanks to a deep V hull and sharp entry that owners trust.
- Functional fishing and family layout featuring livewell/fishboxes, wide walkways, and a foldaway stern seat.
- Compact but practical console head suitable for day trips and short overnight stays.
- Not built for extreme top end speed; the design favors a comfortable cruise over being a go fast hull.
- Limited overnight living space—adequate for short excursions but not ideal for extended liveaboard use.
- Older vessels may need wiring refurbishment and attention to corrosion, and some owners see mid life service or repower on Yamaha 4 strokes.
