OVERVIEW

Shestakov Yacht Sales introduces the Chesapeake 290 from Grady-White Boats, a multi-role 29 foot platform designed around the needs of the sport fisherman yet comfortable enough for weekend cruising. Work directly with Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team to explore current availability and to determine the optimal configuration for your program.

Selecting a Chesapeake 290

If your priority is a fishing-focused vessel that remains simple to handle, the Chesapeake 290 makes a strong case: 29 ft (9.07 m) LOA with a 9 ft (3.02 m) beam. The twin Yamaha gas outboard arrangement keeps ownership and routine maintenance straightforward, while sleeping space for three and a single head make short cruises viable. As a motor yacht built with a sport fisherman emphasis, it couples angling practicality with a cruising range supported by a 206 gallon fuel tank and 32 gallon freshwater capacity.

- Propulsion: Two Yamaha gas outboards provide uncomplicated operation and easy servicing
- Construction: Hull built of fiberglass and plastic with a molded Fiberglass deck

Questions and Answers

- Q: What are the key dimensions of the Chesapeake 290? A: The **LOA** measures 29 ft (9.07 m), the **beam** is 9 ft (3.02 m), and the **draft** (min) is 6.562 ft (2 m).
- Q: What engines power this model? A: It is fitted with twin **Yamaha outboard** engines running on **gas**, chosen for uncomplicated servicing and reliable

performance.

- Q: How is the model classified? A: It is a motor yacht specifically laid out for the sport fisherman role.
- Q: What are the onboard capacities and accommodations? A: The layout **sleeps 3** , includes **1 head** , and carries **206 gal** of fuel with **32 gal** of freshwater.
- Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The hull utilizes fiberglass and plastic, and the deck is molded **Fiberglass** for durability and low maintenance.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the Chesapeake 290 from Grady-White Boats because it bridges dedicated offshore fishing capability with comfortable family cruising. The expansive cockpit, substantial insulated fish boxes, and unobstructed walkaround decks simplify day fishing, while the below decks V berth, midship berth, stand up head, and modest galley create a genuine large-boat ambience for overnight trips. Helm layout is praised, offering clear sightlines and room for twin navigation displays.

On the water, professional evaluations note the design stays dry and composed—even when encountering 4–10 ft seas—and reacts predictably during turns, drifts, and tight quarters maneuvers. Reported performance points to an economical cruise near ~30 mph and a top end around 48 mph when powered by twin 250s, with a substantial hull that delivers a cushioned, big boat ride instead of a sharp, choppy motion.

Routine ownership is largely about preventive maintenance: factory recommendations include annual replacement of fuel filter/water separators and rinsing fuel tank compartments after saltwater exposure. An optional generator is installed beneath a fold away aft bench, and reviewers note the bench's folding design facilitates easy access for service. Because the model

had a relatively limited production run, there are fewer owner reports in forums; therefore, owners stress consistent upkeep and fuel treatment practices rather than chasing recurring mechanical problems.

Pros and Cons

- Dry, stable behavior in heavier seas with a comfortable, big boat feel.
- Flexible interior and cockpit layout that suits both offshore fishing and family overnighting.
- Reported efficient cruise at roughly ~30 mph with a top speed near ~48 mph on twin 250s.
- Reviewers have suggested the helm seat would benefit from a positive locking swivel.
- The compact galley is adequate for quick meal prep but not intended for extensive galley cooking.
- A short production run results in fewer peer to peer reports and troubleshooting threads.
