Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers commonly cite the Freedom 275 as a multi-purpose boat suited to coastal fishing, family day trips, towing inflatables, and quick runs to the beach or waterfront restaurants. The SeaV2 hull is praised for delivering a soft, dry, and stable ride; a Cape Cod owner reports it "does better than most" when facing the frequent chop. Reported real-world numbers match factory figures, with an economical cruise near 30 mph and top-end speeds in the mid- to high-40s depending on power.

The family-oriented layout is frequently mentioned as a strength: forward seating for roughly six around a table, an enclosed port console head with an electric-flush toilet, adjustable helm seating, and a cockpit that balances fishing amenities with lounging space. Owners note the convenience of the livewell, aft fish/ice boxes, and a folding aft seat for transitioning from a morning fishing session to relaxed socializing afterward. For offshore day excursions, several owners feel comfortable venturing out given favorable weather—one owner even says they "wouldn't hesitate" to head out in a 27 with twins when conditions allow—but the model is generally treated as a dayboat rather than an extended offshore cruiser.

On ownership, some buyers have reported cosmetic issues such as gelcoat cracking around snaps and other fit-and-finish complaints, along with occasional installation problems like loose drawers or hardware. Experiences with dealer support and Grady-White Boats warranty responsiveness vary, though many describe proactive follow-up; because the model sits in a premium price tier (one review references about \$177,500 with twin F150s), owners often expect attentive service and in some cases have required

additional warranty work to address defects.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile for coastal fishing, family dayboating, watersports, and quick beach or restaurant runs.
- SeaV2 hull provides a soft, dry, and stable ride, handling common chop well per owner reports.
- Family-friendly layout with bow seating for about six, an enclosed head, and a cockpit that converts between fishing and lounging configurations.
- Some owners report gelcoat cracking and other cosmetic fit-and-finish issues on certain boats.
- Isolated build or installation defects (for example, loose drawers or hardware) have necessitated dealer repairs.
- Dealer responsiveness is inconsistent and warranty follow ups may be required despite the model's premium positioning.
