The Freedom 307 by Grady-White Boats is a multifunctional motor yacht built on a proven fiberglass construction platform. Listed and represented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, this 30-foot model combines twin Yamaha outboard power with practical onboard capacities for confident time on the water.

## Selecting a Freedom 307

---

Opting for the Freedom 307 makes sense when you want a 30 ft motor yacht that delivers a generous 10 ft beam, twin outboard propulsion, and the longevity offered by a fiberglass hull. The boat carries 234 gallons of fuel for extended outings, 32 gallons of fresh water for convenience, and features a dedicated head for onboard comfort. ## Questions and Answers

---

Q: Who is the **builder** of the Freedom 307? A: The Freedom 307 is built by Grady-White Boats.

Q: What **type** of yacht is it and what is the **hull category** ? A: It is a motor yacht featuring a fiberglass construction hull.

Q: What are the **LOA** and **beam** ? A: LOA measures 30 ft (9.17 m) and beam

measures 10 ft (3.23 m).

Q: What **engines** power the yacht and what **fuel** do they use? A: The yacht is powered by two Yamaha outboard engines that run on gas.

Q: What are the **draft** and onboard **capacities** ? A: Draft (min/max) is 6.015 ft (1.8333 m); fuel capacity is 234 gal; water capacity is 32 gal; and there is 1 head.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Launched in 2015, the Freedom 307 from Grady-White Boats has established itself as a flexible dayboat that appeals to families and anglers alike. Owners commonly alternate between relaxed cruises, social sandbar and bay outings with larger groups, and offshore fishing trips 20–30+ miles from shore. The SeaV2 hull is credited with providing a dry, steady ride and a soft entry; many owners report it performs remarkably well for a 30-foot vessel and handles following seas with confidence. Reported cruising speeds sit around 27–30 mph with top speeds approaching 50 mph, and the twin outboards are noted for responsive maneuvering, particularly when equipped with a joystick option. Owners also mention the boat benefits from ample trim and that trim-tab adjustments are frequently needed as people move about the deck.

Deck arrangements get praise for comfort and adaptability: a roomy bow lounge, convertible seating at the port and aft areas, and a double-wide electric helm seat. The compact cabin includes a stand-up head, a sink, and a fold-down berth suitable for one adult; many owners use the cabin primarily for stowage but value the straightforward access. The wet bar/galley with sink (and optional refrigerator) receives favorable feedback, though some owners would refine elements like toilet acoustics or drawer organization, and certain storage areas can feel constrained.

Long-term ownership notes are mainly pragmatic. A few early component

issues appear in owner discussions—examples include an aft bilge float switch, a fuel sender, individual LED fixtures, occasional windlass/anchor snags, and minor gelcoat cracking—while access to some bilge and service locations can be tight. Many owners equip their boats with twin Yamaha F300s, and one wet-slip owner mentioned the lower units may sit roughly two inches submerged. On the positive side, dealer support is commonly commended, with warranty work typically handled promptly.

## Pros and Cons

- Versatile dual-console layout suitable for family cruising, sandbar gatherings, and offshore fishing.
- SeaV2 hull delivers a dry, stable ride with soft entry; twin outboards provide responsive handling and an optional joystick simplifies docking.
- Comfortable seating arrangements throughout, a useful day head, and a practical wet bar/galley.
- Some owners note storage can be limited in certain areas.
- Frequent trim-tab adjustments are needed as people move around on deck.
- Access to specific bilge and service points can be tight.
