## Owner Experience Review

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Owners of the 47 Eastbay FB produced by GRAND BANKS MARINE frequently describe it as a bright, weekend-ready boat: an ideal platform for entertaining on the flybridge and enjoying the salon, with comfortable accommodations that appeal to active couples and family outings. Its configuration lends itself to coastal cruising and marina-to-marina itineraries.

On the water, owners often report that the vessel behaves more like an express cruiser than a traditional slow trawler. Sea trials and owner feedback highlight predictable heel in turns, secure tracking in chop, and responsive

handling. Performance notes typically indicate cruising speeds in the 22–27 knot range with reported top speeds approaching 30 knots on higher-output C 12/C 9 configurations; many owners note it readily sustains speeds above 20 knots.

Inside, reviewers praise a salon finished in classic Grand Banks tradition, featuring teak-and-holly soles and meticulous joinery. Typical layouts show two staterooms with a forward walk-around island berth and a galley-up arrangement, while the flybridge is consistently commended as a convivial space for guests. Owners also point out trade-offs: higher-speed operation with large Caterpillar engines increases fuel burn, routine service items such as exhaust risers, aftercooler cores, and fuel coolers demand attention, and the engine room—though serviceable—can feel tight around elements like the starboard battery bank. Watermakers are commonly aftermarket additions for extended stays at anchor. Specifics will vary by year and engine package, but these observations are common across reports.

## Pros and Cons

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- Express-like handling with responsive turning, a solid feel in choppy conditions, and predictable heel through maneuvers.
- Energetic performance with typical cruise impressions of 22–27 kt and confirmed ability to cruise above 20 knots.
- Refined salon joinery and a functional two-stateroom, galley-up layout complemented by an accommodating flybridge for socializing.
- Significant fuel consumption at higher speeds when fitted with large Cat engines.
- Engine-room access is practical but can be confined around components such as the starboard battery boxes.
- Watermakers are frequently not included as standard equipment, so extended anchoring often relies on aftermarket installation.
