Measuring 72 ft overall, driven by twin Caterpillar inboard diesels, and arranged for six guests plus a dedicated crew cabin, it's a true cruising platform in the fiberglass construction segment. With a 72 ft LOA, a generous beam, and a 110 gross ton designation, the model offers the interior volume needed for comfortable extended voyages, while the twin diesel inboards support efficient cruising speeds. model's typical **cruising speed** is 15 knots (about 17.26 mph) while the **maximum speed** is 18 knots (about 20.71 mph).

Owner Experience Review

Owners favor the 720 Skylounge LRC from HAMPTON YACHTS for its owner-operator practicality and long-range capability. One owner explained, "We wanted a big enough boat that we could drive ourselves..." Feedback consistently praises easy handling and excellent sightlines from the elevated center helm located in the skylounge. Underway the yacht performs like a substantial long-range cruiser, providing a steady, soft ride with ABT stabilizers; published test numbers show top speeds near 20–21 knots, while owners note planning cruise speeds to prioritize range, with best efficiency around 10–12 knots.

Day-to-day, the enclosed skylounge is highlighted as a true all-season living space, complete with a wet bar, day head, outdoor galley area, and expansive

windows. The interior layout supports family voyaging, long-term liveaboard use, and entertaining: a roomy salon, formal dining for eight, a well-appointed galley, heated head floors, laundry facilities, and ample storage for serious provisioning. One owner summed it up: "This Hampton is absolutely feature rich, and is the only yacht we've seen that checks every box."

Regarding maintenance, the twin Caterpillar C18 engines come with the usual service and parts considerations associated with high-output diesels in this class, but reviewers frequently commend the engine-room access and the redundancy built into systems to support owner-operator servicing. Brokerage reports often show examples of careful maintenance, and searches of public listings and forums did not reveal any recurring single-model failures. As always, individual experiences differ, and these comments reflect published reviews and listings rather than a formal statistical study.

Pros and Cons

- Easy for an owner-operator to manage, with excellent visibility from the skylounge's elevated center helm.
- Comfortable and stable on passage, with ABT stabilizers contributing to a composed ride suitable for long distances.
- Enclosed four-season skylounge and expansive interior accommodations support liveaboard cruising and entertaining.
- The high-horsepower Caterpillar C18 package carries maintenance and parts costs typical for engines in this performance bracket.
- Most efficient at roughly 10–12 knots, so operating at higher speeds will reduce range.
- Exhibits the characteristics of a heavy, long-range cruiser—comfort and seakeeping take precedence over sporty, responsive handling in choppy conditions.

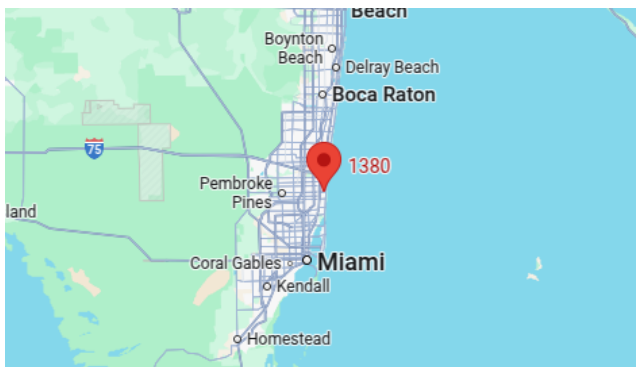
