The 92 ft LOA combined with a 23 ft beam produces significant interior volume, while the single MTU propulsion yields a comfortable 12-knot cruise and an 18-knot top end. The fiberglass-and-plastic hull paired with a fiberglass deck reinforces durability and straightforward maintenance. Owner Experience Review

Owners frequently choose the C92 for family cruising and owner-operated passages throughout the Bahamas and Caribbean, benefiting from capacious tankage and adaptable four-cabin layouts highlighted in listings. The platform is commonly set up for premium private charters and entertaining, thanks to generous main-deck gathering spaces, a foredeck lounge, and an ample flybridge; flexible cockpit and utility configurations also support casual weekend cruising and light sportfishing. One owner, after evaluating models from Horizon, OA, and Benetti, praised HARGRAVE CUSTOM YACHTS for a European-influenced level of finish and noted that guarantees from the builder's newer facility justified the higher price.

Sea-trial and published figures show an efficient cruising band of 12–15 knots at approximately 1400–1800 rpm, with top speeds near 21 knots at roughly 2250 rpm. Several C92s are equipped with very large fuel tanks (around 5,000 USG on certain builds), supporting a long-range mission—one broker spec cites a 2,000-nm example. Numerous yachts in the series carry Naiad At-Rest stabilization, which significantly enhances comfort at anchor and dampens motion underway.

Accommodation plans often include on-deck or full-beam master suites, three

to four guest staterooms below, and separate crew quarters with ample storage and thoughtful owner/crew separation. Broker and owner reports consistently call out refined joinery, bespoke woodwork, expansive salon glazing, and a well-located main-deck galley; some examples add dedicated laundry or fitness areas and discreet crew service routes to optimize operations. As with any highly customized yacht, service expectations vary: engine selections differ by hull (commonly MTU 10V2000M96 or CAT), routine 1,000-hour tasks and generator heat-exchanger maintenance appear in service logs, engine rooms are generally accessible but densely outfitted, and brokers recommend a thorough survey with service records and confirmation of stabilizer, watermaker, and HVAC maintenance histories.

Pros and Cons

- Long-range potential enabled by very large fuel reserves on select builds and practical four-cabin layouts suitable for owner operation.
- Generous entertainment spaces (main deck, foredeck lounge, expansive flybridge) make the yacht well suited to private charter and hosting guests.
- Many examples are fitted with Naiad At-Rest stabilization, which improves comfort both underway and at anchor.
- High levels of customization mean maintenance requirements and costs can vary widely between hulls and option packages.
- Engine packages vary (for example, MTU or CAT), so parts procurement and service planning need careful attention.
- Dense equipment installation on the 92-foot platform can complicate some engine-room access and demands disciplined organization.

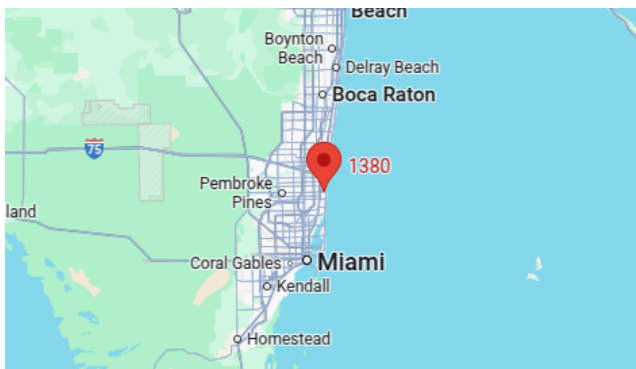
