Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers typically describe the Enclosed Skybridge from HARGRAVE CUSTOM YACHTS as an earnest family cruiser—simple to live aboard for short escapes yet capable for longer coastal passages. The enclosed skybridge translates into a notably large pilothouse, and 88–90' examples on the market frequently exhibit spacious salons with country galley layouts, several guest cabins, and in some instances as many as five heads. Many owners note that the original interiors can feel “a little woody,” a look many choose to modernize over time.

Underway, owners often settle into a comfortable 10–12 knot cruising speed and report that the yacht “rode, responded all well,” while also pointing out a tendency to rock or roll both at anchor and underway. The model is commonly used for extended coastal runs—Caribbean and New England style itineraries are often mentioned—supported by generous storage and fuel capacity. Many owners operate with an owner captain arrangement or a two person crew. Routine used boat maintenance is typical: several older examples show gelcoat or paint cracking around combings, original stainless fittings can require frequent polishing unless upgraded, and common owner improvements include anchor package upgrades and teak replacement. One survey of a 101' build noted the need for backing plates on the steering gear, highlighting the importance of comprehensive inspections.

Pros and Cons

- Family oriented design with a large enclosed pilothouse and, in 88–90' examples, a roomy salon/country galley and multiple guest cabins.
- Comfortable 10–12 knot cruising range with handling described as riding and responding well.
- Well suited to extended coastal passages and practical for owner operators running with a small crew or captain.
- Exhibits a propensity to rock and roll both at anchor and when underway.
- Older builds may suffer gelcoat/paint cracking and will often need repeated stainless polishing unless fittings have been upgraded.
- Anticipate standard refit items such as anchor package improvements, teak replacement, and occasional steering or hardware reinforcement as noted in some surveys.

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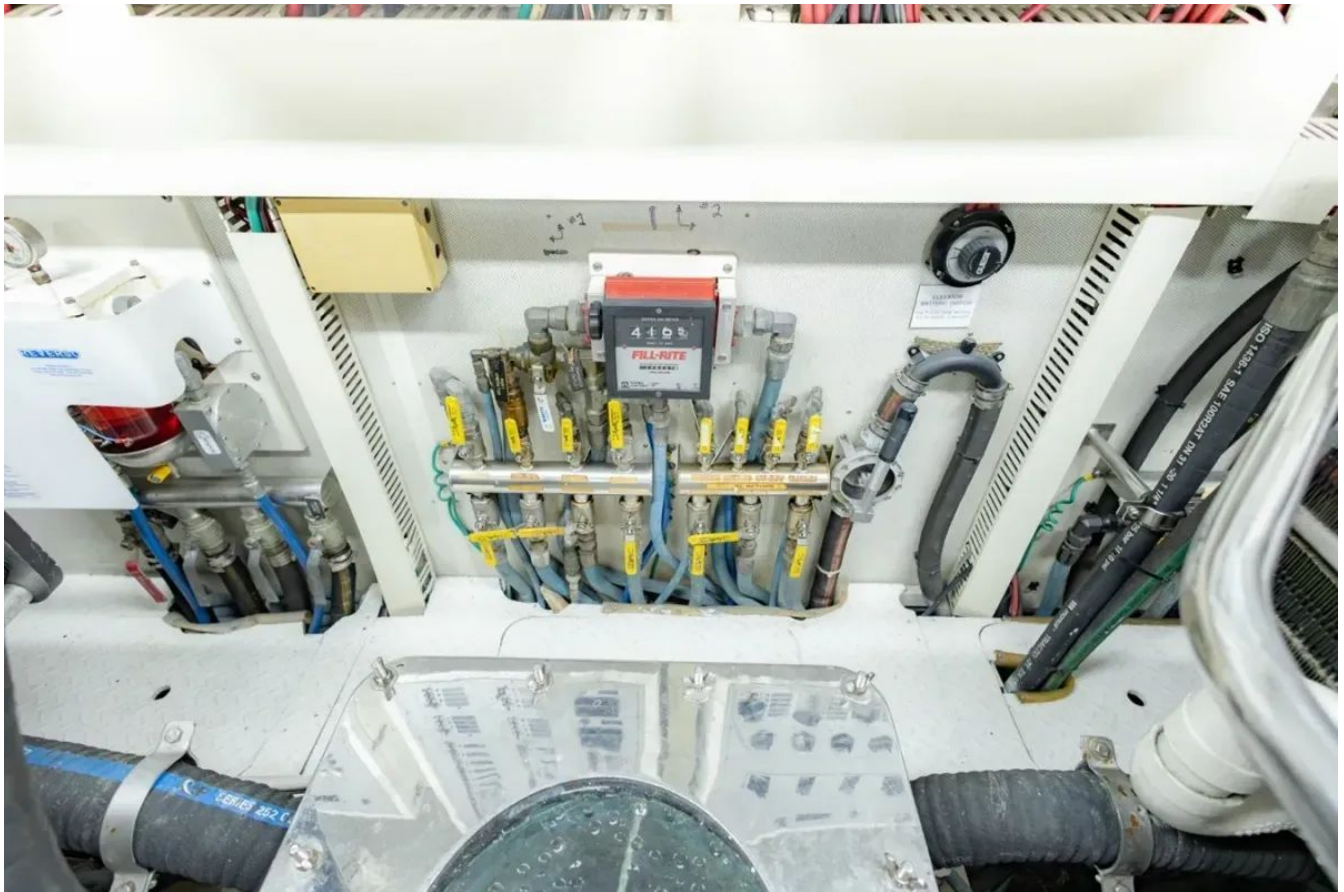

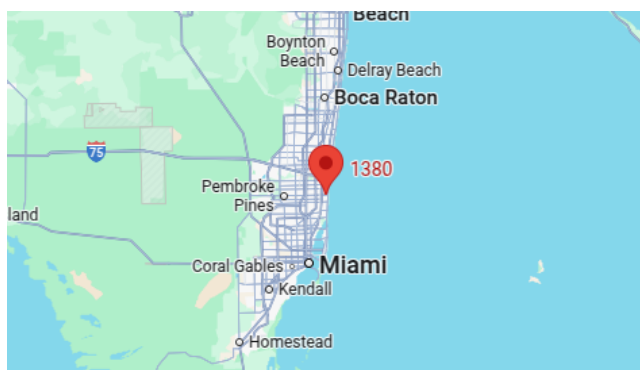
