Designed and produced by Hatteras, it pairs a Semi-Displacement hull form with strong performance and practical liveboard arrangements for extended trips. Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 60GT? A: It is a motor yacht designed specifically as a sport fisherman, marrying speed with dedicated fishing capability.

Q: What are the speeds of the 60GT? A: The **cruising speed** is 32 kn (36.83 mph), and the **maximum speed** is 39 kn (44.88 mph).

Q: What engines power the 60GT? A: It is propelled by **2 x Caterpillar** engines using **Diesel** fuel.

Q: How many people can sleep aboard? A: **Accommodations** sleep 6 and include **3 heads** , plus a **crew cabin** fitted with 2 berths.

Q: What are the hull details? A: The **hull configuration** is Semi-Displacement and the **hull material** is fiberglass and plastic.

Owner Experience Review

Owners operating the 60GT from Hatteras commonly describe it as a tournament-oriented platform, noting a large, efficiently arranged cockpit and fishbox configuration. The mezzanine is praised for serving both as social seating and as deep storage/freezer space, while the flybridge helm is frequently commended for its center-console ergonomics, tidy electronics integration, and excellent sightlines; recurring minor critiques include the desire for easier-to-reach trim-tab controls and the addition of more overhead grab rails.

Sea trials typically report a top end in the 41–42-knot range and cruising in the mid-30s, with the boat remaining steady when driving into 4–5-foot seas at

about 26 knots. In some conditions and at certain speeds the motion can become lively — one reviewer observed that “even a ninety thousand pound boat at this speed jumps and jitters” — yet the consensus is that the yacht delivers both speed and control for tournament efforts and long transits between fishing grounds.

Onboard accommodations offer multiple interior layouts (three- or four-stateroom options) with mahogany joinery that make the salon and dinette inviting for family or crew, and many owners report practical fuel capacity in the roughly 1,500–1,800-gallon band to support extended, owner-operated cruising. Maintenance aligns with the performance profile: twin Caterpillar C32 ACERTs of roughly 1,800 hp each provide the pace but are thirsty at WOT and carry notable service and parts expenses. Owners appreciate the generous engine-room access from the cockpit and clear service space around main engines and auxiliaries, though significant drivetrain work has been recorded on a Hatteras 60 (including a documented cracked-shaft repair), and community advice often stresses budgeting for ongoing maintenance, refits, insurance, and use of Hatteras dealer support.

Pros and Cons

- Tournament-ready cockpit and mezzanine with roughly 153 sq ft of working area and generous storage/freezer capacity.
- Confident performance with a reported 41–42-knot top and comfortable 26-knot head-sea ride.
- Flexible three- or four-stateroom layouts with mahogany joinery suit extended cruising and weekends.
- High fuel burn at WOT and significant service costs associated with twin C32 ACERTs.
- Some flybridge ergonomics could improve, including trim-tab switch placement and need for overhead grab rails.

- Documented major drivetrain repairs on a Hatteras 60 highlight the importance of contingency budgeting.
