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OVERVIEW

Purpose-built for extended offshore comfort, the 65 LRC from Hatteras is a motor yacht in the cruiser category constructed with a robust fiberglass and plastic hull. With an LOA of 65 ft (19.81 m), an 18 ft (5.49 m) beam, and ample fuel and water stores, the design supports multi-day or extended bluewater passages. If twin diesel inboards and uncomplicated systems are priorities, the Detroit Diesel propulsion package and diesel fuel configuration are well suited. Q: What type of yacht is the 65 LRC by Hatteras? A: It's a motor yacht marketed as a cruiser built with a fiberglass and plastic hull, designed with range and onboard comfort in mind. Notable attributes include **type** , **class** , and **hull** construction.

Q: How many people can sleep aboard and what amenities are included? A: The interior arrangement accommodates **Sleeps: 4** and includes **Heads: 2** , providing functional berths and facilities for family cruising or guests on longer passages.

Owner Experience Review

Owners drawn to the 65 LRC by Hatteras typically seek a true long range passage vessel. Broker data and owner feedback often reference a range in the neighborhood of 2,300–2,500+ nautical miles, and the displacement hull (1982–1985 models) performs comfortably around a 10 knot hull speed. Most owners report efficient cruising within the 8–12 knot band; as one owner described their experience: "I cruise 11.2 knots at 1525 RPM on 12v71TI's. I back down to 1450 RPM, still manage 10.8, but cut my fuel burn from 16 to 12."

On a daily basis, the yacht is equipped for extended life at sea: owner accounts and listings frequently highlight a full beam owner's stateroom, additional guest berths, an enclosed pilothouse and a deckhouse galley. Another owner summarized the economical mindset: "She cruises at 9 knots @ 1,400RPM

while burning 8GPH total. I could live with that." The interior reflects a teak forward 1980s aesthetic that many owners modernize during refits to upgrade systems and refresh décor.

Maintenance realities are consistent with a vintage Hatteras: the original Detroit 6 71/12V71 family engines remain supported for parts, but they require routine attention to components like heat exchangers, raw water pumps and exhaust hardware. Crew and owners appreciate a stand up engine room with near 360° access, yet larger refit undertakings—genset replacement/overhaul, electrical system modernization, and occasional core or flybridge deck repairs—are commonly encountered and can be significant on a 1980s 65 footer. Many boats are owner or captain run and are either maintained to modern standards or taken on as comprehensive refit projects.

Pros and Cons

Pros

- Long range capability of roughly 2,300–2,500+ nm supports true passagemaking.
- Sea kindly displacement hull delivers a soft ride around a 10 knot hull speed.
- Stand up engine room with 360° service access simplifies maintenance.

Cons

- Original Detroit 6 71/12V71 engines are vintage and demand regular attention to heat exchangers, pumps, and exhaust components.
- Many examples need costly modernization—genset work, electrical upgrades, and occasional core/flybridge deck repairs.
- Economical cruise in the 8–12 knot range means passages take time compared with faster designs.
