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If your goal is a compact yet capable boat for day runs or short cruises, the 39 Speciale delivers a balanced package. Measuring 39 ft (11.89 m) overall with an 11 ft (3.5 m) beam, it offers a sensible footprint without sacrificing usable deck and cabin space. Power comes from three Yamaha outboards for assured maneuverability, while Gas/Petrol propulsion simplifies fueling and service. With one head, a 47-gallon freshwater tank, and a 525-gallon fuel capacity, it supports extended days and occasional overnight trips. As a motor yacht in the cruiser class with a fiberglass hull, it's designed for practical ownership and routine maintenance.

## Owner Experience Review

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Across owner feedback and professional sea trials, the 39 Speciale from HCB demonstrates versatility that matches real-world use. Offshore owners often outfit the boat with twin 40 gallon transom livewells, ample fishboxes, and optional outriggers for targeting pelagic species. For family cruising, the below helm private cabin with a double berth plus an enclosed head enables genuine overnight comfort, while the roomy aft cockpit with a rear facing lounge that converts into tackle storage or a summer kitchen makes it an excellent entertaining dayboat. Handling and control consistently earn praise.

On the water, reviewers note the 39's quick hole shot and the feel of the heavy-built hull—often described as having a Kevlar reinforced keel—that tends to keep the bow low and the deck stable in beam seas. In triple-outboard test configurations, recorded top speeds reached the high 50s mph, with economical cruise speeds commonly reported in the mid 40s to around 50 mph. The helm is substantial, generally accommodating a 16 inch chart display flanked by two 12 inch screens, with three comfortable helm seats secured beneath an expansive hardtop; fit and finish receive positive marks, down to details like a gunwale door that “clicks shut like a premium car door.”

Day to day ownership follows typical outboard routines: scheduled 100 hour and manufacturer service intervals for Yamaha or Mercury power units and

careful logging of engine hours. Brokerage summaries often highlight examples kept “exceptionally maintained,” and many buyers explore options such as a Seakeeper stabilizer, a genset, or larger-capacity systems—each of which adds service items and alters weight and fuel planning. On a vessel equipped with a Seakeeper Ride 750, a recent sea trial documented approximately 26% roll reduction and 37% pitch reduction. Importantly, expert assessments and listings have not revealed widespread structural or systems defects, though most public commentary comes from professional testing and sales listings rather than extended owner journals.

## Pros and Cons

- Confident handling is a recurring compliment, with brisk hole shots and limited bow rise.
- Offshore fishing capability is strong with twin 40 gal transom livewells, fishboxes, and optional outriggers.
- Genuine overnighting is enabled by a private cabin with a double berth and an enclosed head.
- Outboard propulsion mandates routine 100 hour service intervals and vigilant tracking of engine hours.
- Optional systems such as a Seakeeper, genset, or large capacity equipment increase maintenance demands and affect weight/fuel calculations.
- Published performance and stability improvements are based on specific test configurations (e.g., triple outboards, Seakeeper Ride 750), so individual results will vary depending on power, load, and equipment.
