Driven by twin Mercury outboards running on gas, it balances capable performance with a practical single-head interior, a 614-gallon fuel supply, and 40 gallons of freshwater capacity. Its 42 ft overall length and 12 ft beam give it balanced proportions, while the twin Mercury outboards deliver straightforward, gasoline-powered propulsion that's easy to maintain. Built on a durable fiberglass-and-plastic hull with a fiberglass deck, it's designed for coastal runs and offshore days out.

Owner Experience Review

Owners select the 42 Lujo from HCB as a center-console that delivers yacht-level amenities while remaining highly capable for fishing. Many listings and owner reports note a one-cabin layout with a head and air conditioning, making it suitable for extended weekends, while the cockpit accommodates outriggers, large livewells, and spacious fishboxes when configured for tournaments.

On the water, owners commonly describe the ride as "Irish-butter smooth," crediting a hull refinement that minimizes bow rise during acceleration. Reports highlight confident behavior in choppy conditions, and added options such as a Seakeeper and joystick/SpotLock greatly enhance station-keeping; with typical 425/600 outboard setups, cruise speeds generally sit around 40–45 knots, while top speeds may range from the mid-60s into the 70+ knot territory depending on installed power.

Accommodation and finish lean more toward a compact yacht than a stripped-down fishing machine: upscale cabin appointments (teak trim, premium upholstery, galley, TV), air conditioning, and an updated helm featuring three captain seats and large multifunction displays earn frequent compliments, plus owners appreciate broad customization choices. Ownership

does carry higher operating costs due to multiple large outboards—forums point to per-engine 100-hour service intervals—while used market notes often stress extended engine warranties, complete service records, and examples where owners have spent roughly \$125,000 on maintenance and upgrades since delivery; many vessels are lift- or covered-kept with low hours, so prospective buyers should verify service history and warranty coverage.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile platform for family cruising, tournament fishing, and upscale day boating.
- "Irish-butter smooth ride" with reduced bow rise and confident manners in chop.
- Near yacht comforts in a center console: luxury one-cabin layout with A/C and an ergonomic three seat helm.
- Ongoing maintenance is costly with multiple big outboards, and 100 hour service bills add up.
- Compact one cabin arrangement limits overnight capacity for crews or families.
- Best station keeping benefits depend on optional systems like Seakeeper and joystick/SpotLock.

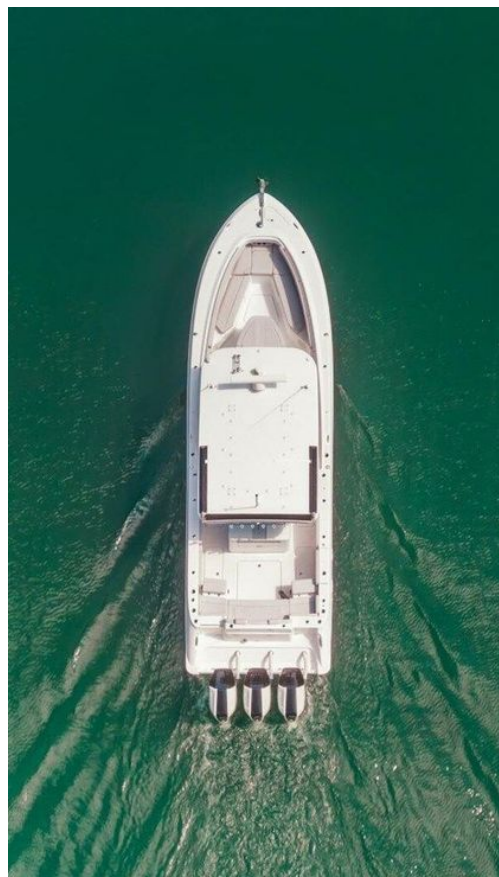
