Q: What type of yacht is the 48 Campeon? A: It is a motor yacht in the center console yacht segment, constructed by HCB using fiberglass and plastic. These core **type** and **category** elements define it as a premium center-console design.

Q: What engines power the yacht? A: The vessel is driven by **4 Yamaha outboard** engines that run on **Gas/Petrol**, chosen for straightforward maintenance and reliable performance.

Q: What are the principal dimensions? A: **LOA** measures 47 ft (14.48 m), **beam** is 13 ft (4.17 m), and **draft** spans 8.202 to 11.756 ft (2.5–3.5833 m).

Q: What accommodations are provided? A: The layout offers **accommodations** for 2, **sleeps** 1, and includes **heads** 1 to support practical overnighting.

Owner Experience Review

Owners gravitate to the 48 Campeon from HCB for family cruising, tournament and offshore fishing, and relaxed weekend entertaining. Listings and walkthroughs frequently note a cabin with a head and optional features such as a galley/summer-kitchen and refrigeration that extend the boat's multi-day capability; forward seating equipped with a convertible table can transform into a sunpad or a casting platform, while the raised skybox seating affords unobstructed 360° sightlines. One forum tour captured cabin access succinctly: "The front entry to the Center Console really opens things up for a much larger birth below!" and owners praise JL audio systems and convivial seating arrangements that keep social days on the water lively.

On the water, owners and dealers often describe a "Signature HCB ride that dominates in any sea state," noting composed handling in demanding conditions and especially steady running when a Seakeeper 6 is installed. Sea trials report brisk top-end speeds and rapid acceleration from quad outboards — examples cited include quad Mercury V12 600s and quad Yamaha 450s.

Serviceability is helped by a dedicated walk-in machine room for the generator and key systems, though early-adopter forums on the 600-hp Verados caution that attentive—and sometimes expensive—electrical/PCM and turbo-related maintenance may be necessary; owners of larger HCB models also acknowledge that large-format covers, teak surfaces, and upholstery demand increased upkeep, describing it as "a hassle but well worth it."

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, confidence-inspiring ride across varied sea conditions, with particularly stable performance when fitted with a Seakeeper 6.
- Strong high-speed capability and rapid throttle response from quad outboards, including options like quad Mercury V12 600 or quad Yamaha 450 setups.
- Service-friendly design featuring a dedicated walk-in machine room for the generator and essential systems.
- Some buyers feel the interior is somewhat plain, despite accent choices that add visual interest.
- Early-adopter feedback on Mercury 600s highlights the need for attentive—and occasionally costly—electrical/PCM and turbo-related servicing in certain cases.
- Larger coverage pieces, teak decks, and upholstery items require additional maintenance time and care.
