OVERVIEW

The 53 Sueños from HCB is a high performance center console — classified as a motor yacht in the center console segment — built on a sturdy fiberglass construction platform. Propelled by four Yamaha outboards, it comfortably cruises at 42 knots and can reach up to 60 knots, backed by generous fuel and water storage for extended offshore excursions. - A broad 13 ft beam that enhances stability and creates generous deck ergonomics.
- A robust fiberglass and plastic hull with a composite deck and a sensible onboard plan that includes one head.

- What kind of yacht is the 53 Sueños?
- The vessel is listed as a motor yacht arranged in a premium center console format and built on a fiberglass and plastic hull.
- What engines power the boat and how fast is it?
- It is equipped with 4 x Yamaha **outboard engines** (Gas/Petrol) and posts a **cruise speed** of 42 kn (48.33 mph) with a **maximum speed** of 60 kn (69.05 mph).
- What are the key dimensions?
- **LOA** is 53 ft (16.15 m), **beam** measures 13 ft (3.96 m), and **draft (min)** is 6.562 ft (2 m).
- What are the main capacities and onboard amenities?
- **Fuel capacity** is 3000 gal, **fresh water** capacity is 100 gal, and the yacht includes **1 head** .

Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers characterize the 53 Sueños from HCB as a two role center console: a tournament ready fishing platform and an upscale day boat.

Its expansive cockpit, integrated livewells, outriggers and optional tuna tower suit serious anglers, while amenities such as a summer kitchen, plentiful seating and a mezzanine fridge/freezer make entertaining straightforward. Belowdecks, a cabin with a queen berth, separate head and shower, a compact galley, plus generator and air conditioning permit comfortable one to two night stays for a boat in this category.

On the water, many owners report a dry and steady ride aided by the 22° transom deadrise, and Seakeeper installations are commonly cited for improving comfort in choppy conditions. When fitted with more powerful quad outboards — from Mercury V12 600s to Yamaha 425/450s — brokerage listings and spec pages note cruising and top speeds that often fall into the high 40s to over 50 knots, varying by engine choice and load.

From an ownership perspective, maintaining four outboards is part of the equation, and a number of listings document engine upgrades or full repowers, including conversions to quad Yamaha 425s. Service records and refit notes frequently mention Seakeeper gyros and onboard generators. At the same time, forum discussions reveal some variability in build assembly and trim and occasional isolated structural or incident reports, so a comprehensive sea trial, a detailed survey, and a careful review of a particular boat's history are strongly recommended.

Pros and Cons

- Designed for serious sportfishing with a roomy cockpit, dedicated livewells, outriggers, and optional tower equipment.
- True overnight capability for a center console thanks to a queen berth, separate head and shower, a compact galley, and generator/AC.
- Dry, stable ride from a 22° deadrise with the option to add a Seakeeper, and the potential for high 40s to 50+ knot performance with quad outboards.

- Some owners and online posts report inconsistencies in assembly and trim, so a thorough sea trial and professional survey are important.
- There are isolated online threads discussing incidents or structural concerns, underscoring the need to inspect any individual boat's history carefully.
- Quad outboards, a Seakeeper, and a generator increase ongoing maintenance needs and may lead to future repower costs.
