## OVERVIEW

---

The 56 Suenos from HCB is an assertive, large-format motor yacht built on a fiberglass hull and engineered to deliver substantial capacity, performance, and liveaboard comfort for extended cruises. Listed by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, this model combines a five engine outboard package with generous tankage and guest accommodations to satisfy demanding owners.

### Selecting a 56 Suenos

---

Opting for the 56 Suenos prioritizes generous scale, robust propulsion, and onboard comfort within a premium center console style. Measuring 56 ft (17.07 m) LOA with a 15 ft (4.57 m) beam, it delivers a broad footprint and inherent stability. Powered by five Mercury outboards and backed by a 1,400 gallon fuel reserve, it's configured for long-range runs and redundancy. Interior arrangements sleep up to 4 with a single head, giving straightforward overnight capability.

Q: Who builds the 56 Suenos? A: The 56 Suenos is manufactured by HCB, a respected builder known for premium center console designs and **high-quality construction** .

Q: What type of yacht is it, and what is the hull made of? A: It is a motor yacht built with a fiberglass and plastic hull, offering a combination of **strength** and **low-maintenance** characteristics.

Q: What are the overall dimensions? A: Overall length is **56 ft (17.07 m)** , beam measures **15 ft (4.57 m)** , and the **max draft** is listed at 15.026 ft (4.58 m).

Q: What propulsion does it use and what fuel type? A: Propulsion is provided by **five Mercury outboards** that run on **gas/petrol** , delivering dependable multi engine performance.

Q: How many people can it accommodate and how many heads are onboard?

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and reviewers position the 56 Suenos as an able sportfishing platform that also doubles as a family cruiser for island hopping and large group day boating. Dealer spec examples and owner feedback highlight abundant rod storage, sizable fishboxes, and adaptable cockpit and salon seating, so the boat performs equally well chasing pelagics or entertaining groups. Introduced in the mid 2020s and marketed as 2025–2026 model years, it seeks to marry yacht level comfort with the performance anglers demand.

On the water, sea trials commonly report a composed, planted ride through

chop with minimal bow rise and notable stability. In reviews of a quint 600 Mercury setup, cruising speeds near 45 mph and top speeds around 65 mph were observed, while onboard comfort felt closer to a larger yacht. The covered helm and forward lounge are frequently described as very spacious, with shaded and convertible seating stretching from bow to stern; popular options include helm and second row AC, a powered sunshade, and a Seakeeper gyro for extended runs or summer entertaining.

For weekending and longer trips, the two stateroom arrangement sleeps four comfortably, the galley supports several weeks of cruising needs, and interior headroom exceeds 6½ feet. Serviceability is a strength: a walk in machinery space beneath the cockpit allows owner or crew access to the genset and systems. HCB's Bolt digital switching consolidates many controls—convenient but increasing reliance on electronics—and owners appreciate single key ignition options on large Mercury 600 installations. Forum commentary has praised cleaner wiring runs while noting finishes stop short of ultra luxury, and to date there have been no widespread, recurring mechanical complaints specific to the platform.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Confident, stable ride in chop with minimal bow rise; tests reported ~45 mph cruise and ~65 mph top on quint 600s.
- Two staterooms, headroom well over 6.5 feet, and a galley described as adequate for weeks support multi day cruising.
- Walk in machinery space, single key ignition for the 600s, and centralized Bolt controls ease operation and service.
- Bolt digital switching centralizes control and creates reliance on electronic interfaces.
- Forum observers describe wiring as tidy but not high end.
- Numerous comfort options (AC, Seakeeper, power sunshade) add systems

that require attention and upkeep.
