OVERVIEW

The 65 Estrella from HCB redefines what a large, luxury center console can be. As a motor yacht in the center console class built on a fiberglass construction hull, it marries offshore seaworthiness with upscale day-boat amenities. Selecting a 65 Estrella

Opting for the 65 Estrella prioritizes expansive deck real estate, robust propulsion, and flexible use-cases. With a 67 ft (20.57 m) LOA and a 16 ft (4.88 m) beam it provides the footprint required for extended cruising and lively entertaining, while a six engine Mercury outboard setup produces the kind of performance owners expect. As a motor yacht conceived as a true center console layout and constructed with a fiberglass hull, it delivers confident handling, longevity, and offshore capability.

Features of the Model

- Deep Vee hull form engineered for secure offshore runs and stable behavior at higher speeds.
- Six Mercury outboards (gas, outboard) providing strong throttle response, performance redundancy, and offshore reliability.
- A wide 16 ft beam that supports sizeable deck areas for guests, tackle, and entertainment setups.
- Large fuel capacity (1,730 gal) designed to stretch range and reduce the frequency of refueling on long passages.
- Fiberglass deck and a fiberglass construction hull for proven durability and low-maintenance longevity.

- Built as an upscale center console platform within the motor yacht class, suitable for both adventurous offshore outings and luxury day cruising.

Q: What sets the 65 Estrella apart among large center consoles? A: Its mix of **size** , **power** , and **range-ready fuel capacity** positions it near the top of the

center console segment, while retaining the comforts and presentation of a motor yacht designed for upscale day-boat use.

Q: What engines power the boat? A: It is driven by **six Mercury outboards** running on **gas** , a configuration that offers immediate throttle response and operational redundancy valued for offshore passages.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The yacht measures **67 ft (20.57 m)** LOA, has a beam of **16 ft (4.88 m)** , and a draft that spans **9.843 ft to 13.123 ft (3 m to 4 m)** , balancing seakeeping, load capacity, and offshore capability.

Owner Experience Review

Since the model's design debut in 2018 and the sea trials that followed in 2019, owners have deployed the 65 Estrella from HCB as both a substantial offshore sportfishing platform and a family friendly cruiser for island loops and overnight trips. The below decks accommodations are often compared to mid size yacht standards, typically including stateroom(s), full head(s), and a galley that render longer passages comfortable. As a day boat and showpiece it performs well—users praise the roomy cockpit and deck layout for fishing and entertaining, and comments on fit and upholstery quality are consistently positive.

On the water, the helm benefits from large, integrated electronics and intuitive

electronic/hydraulic systems that help an owner operator manage the vessel's scale; one sea trial reviewer described it as a "sweet baby to handle in any conditions." Reports from cruising areas like the Keys emphasize a secure offshore ride, and the multiple high horsepower outboards provide brisk acceleration plus the kind of range and cruising speed that make Bahamas passages practical.

Owners also emphasize the maintenance trade-offs: an array of high output outboards increases the number of service touchpoints, driving higher routine costs and more inspection time, although the outboard layout can simplify some mechanical access compared with inboard diesel arrangements. Online discussions note that engine selection and parts/support history should factor into ownership planning, and that the extensive electronics and hydraulic systems carry service costs above those of typical small boats. Performance recollections vary by individual build—some report top speeds near 70 mph while others feel the boat is not exceptionally quick given its mass—so setting realistic performance expectations is advised.

Pros and Cons

- Offshore-capable hull with a roomy cockpit and fishing-focused ergonomics that accommodate crews and guests.
- Below deck accommodations similar to a mid size yacht—stateroom(s), full head(s), and a galley—suitable for extended island cruises and family stays.
- Large integrated navigation and control systems plus user-friendly electronic/hydraulic helm controls that simplify handling of a large hull.
- Multiple high output outboards increase complexity of maintenance and raise recurring service expenses compared with simpler propulsion arrangements.
- Owners report variable top speed performance; some configurations approach 70 mph while others feel less quick relative to the boat's size and

installed power.

- Extensive electronics, hydraulics, and systems result in higher ongoing service bills than those typical of smaller vessels.
