## OVERVIEW

---

The 36 Sundeck Trawler by HERITAGE EAST is a compact long range motor yacht rendered in the traditional trawler silhouette, built on a robust fiberglass and plastic hull. Its propulsion comes from a single inboard diesel supplied by Cummins, configured to favor economical, steady cruising over speed. With practical tankage and two heads, it is well suited to extended passages and liveaboard use. For availability or brokerage assistance, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

### Selecting a [36 Sundeck Trawler](#)

---

Opt for the 36 Sundeck Trawler if you prioritize efficient displacement cruising and uncomplicated systems. Its single inboard diesel emphasizes fuel economy rather than high speeds, with a typical cruising pace of 5 kn (5.75 mph) and a top end of 9 kn (10.36 mph). Large tanks—420 gal of fuel and 180 gal of freshwater—extend the time you can remain at sea. Remember the vessel's dimensions: 36 ft (11 m) LOA, 12 ft (3.84 m) beam, and a draft of 12.03 ft (3.6666 m) when assessing your favored cruising grounds and berth requirements.

- Heritage efficiency: single inboard **Cummins** diesel for simple, economical operation
- Enduring build: fiberglass and plastic hull with a Fiberglass deck
- Cruising focus: 5 kn cruise / 9 kn max for relaxed, fuel savvy passages
- Endurance capacities: 420 gal fuel and 180 gal water
- Onboard comfort: 2 heads to serve guests and crew
- Category fit: a compact motor yacht in the traditional trawler idiom

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What are the cruising and maximum speeds of the 36 Sundeck Trawler? A: The **cruising speed** is 5 kn (5.75 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 9 kn (10.36 mph).

Q: What powers this yacht? A: It is equipped with a single **Cummins inboard**

**diesel** engine.

Q: How much fuel and water can it carry? A: **Fuel capacity** is 420 gal, and **water capacity** is 180 gal.

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The hull is a fiberglass and plastic construction, and the **deck** is Fiberglass.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly choose the 36 Sundeck Trawler from HERITAGE EAST for coastal family cruising or for couples seeking a comfortable liveaboard. The layout—two cabins with the galley down—delivers more interior volume than many other 36-foot boats. The aft cabin spans the full beam and features an island queen berth, plentiful built-in storage, and large salon windows that brighten the living spaces, making extended stays aboard practical. Warm joinery, including teak-and-holly soles and solid woodwork, enhances the onboard ambiance, while molded transom steps, molded access to the sundeck, broad side decks, and substantial railings facilitate safe movement and boarding.

Underway, the semi-displacement hull is tuned for economical, comfortable passages in the 8–10 knot range; one trial recorded approximately 9 knots at 2000 rpm while consuming about 3.5 gallons per hour. Owners describe the motion as steady and somewhat languid, and the full-length keel with prop protection and hard chines provides predictable tracking and durability. The yacht is frequently managed by two people, and its shallow 3 ft 8 in draft opens routes into canals and shallow waterways; owners have completed

Great Loop-style voyages, including a cruise from Florida to Canada via Lake Champlain, the Rideau Canal, and the St. Lawrence River.

Maintenance access rates highly: the single Cummins 6BT/6BT5.9 (roughly 210–220 hp) is noted for dependability, with roughly 24 inches of clearance around the engine and easy access through hinged galley steps and lift-up salon hatches. While no systemic catastrophic faults have been reported, owners often upgrade factory systems—adding dual-switchable Racor fuel filters, modern AGM deep-cycle battery banks, a three-phase charger, and a sound shield for the genset. Because some steps and lockers open directly into the engine space, noise can be an issue; cabin noise on an unfurnished example measured about 79.5 dB, so additional soundproofing is a common enhancement.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Interior is unusually spacious for 36 feet, with two cabins and a full-beam aft master with an island queen.
- Economical, comfortable cruise around 8–10 knots, about 9 knots at 2000 rpm burning roughly 3.5 gph.
- Shallow 3 ft 8 in draft, full-length keel, and hard chines enable canal cruising with good tracking and prop protection.
- Some steps and lockers open to the engine room, making the boat louder than necessary underway.
- Cabin sound was measured around 79.5 dB on an unfurnished example, so added sound deadening is advisable.
- Factory electrical and fuel setups often benefit from upgrades such as AGM batteries, dual-switchable Racor filters, and a genset sound shield.
