Measuring 82 ft (24.99 m) overall with a 20 ft (6.1 m) beam, it provides the stable deck plan expected of premium motor yachts. A cruising speed of 14 knots and a top end of 24 knots broaden possible itineraries, while its generous fuel and water reserves allow for extended time away from port. Q: What type of yacht is the 82 SkyLounge? A: It is a motor yacht in the motor yachts category, constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the 82 SkyLounge? A: The **dimensions** are LOA 82 ft (24.99 m), **beam** 20 ft (6.1 m), and **max draft** 20.768 ft (6.33 m).

Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers routinely describe the 82 SkyLounge from Horizon Yachts as a capable and practical platform for both overnighting and day trips. The enclosed Skylounge significantly increases usable interior volume, and commonly specified three-stateroom layouts—with a full-beam midship master and high-quality finishes—deliver an owner-focused living experience. With crew quarters aft and private access, the layout supports either owner-operators who prefer to run the boat themselves or owners employing professional crew.

When underway, examples equipped with C30 powerplants frequently report a cruising speed near 17 knots and a top speed around 21 knots. Owners and brokers praise the yacht's sure-footed handling; ABT fin stabilizers are noted for markedly reducing roll at sea and at anchor, while bow and stern thrusters make docking and tight maneuvers much simpler.

Maintenance and routine care are straightforward thanks to a walk-in engine

room with Delta-T ventilation, dedicated air conditioning and soundproofing, diamond-plate service flooring, and a Fireboy suppression system. In planning ownership, expect standard Caterpillar maintenance intervals (and to budget for major overhauls on high-hour mains), plus ongoing attention to the stabilizers, bow/stern thrusters, and the often multiple generators found aboard.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile layout and systems that accommodate both family overnighting and day cruising, suitable for owner-operators or those with professional crew.
- Enclosed Skylounge and three-stateroom plans with a full-beam master provide expansive interior volume and premium finishes.
- ABT fin stabilizers combined with bow and stern thrusters yield confident handling, reduced roll, and easier close-quarters operations.
- Typical C30-equipped examples cruise near 17 knots with a top speed around 21 knots, which may disappoint buyers seeking higher-speed performance.
- A greater number of onboard systems increases routine maintenance needs for stabilizers, bow/stern thrusters, and multiple gensets.
- Caterpillar main engines require adherence to standard service schedules and planning for major service costs on high-hour units.

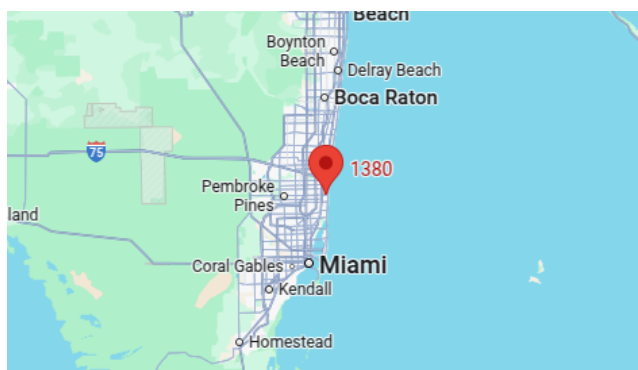
