## OVERVIEW

---

Crafted by Horizon Yachts, the E88 is an 88 ft (26.82 m) motor yacht built on a fiberglass construction hull and driven by twin Caterpillar inboard diesels. She sleeps up to 8 guests, offers 6 heads, cruises comfortably at 18 knots (20.71 mph) and will reach a maximum of 23 knots (26.47 mph). ## Selecting a E88

---

Opt for the E88 when you want an elegant 88 ft LOA motor yacht with a roomy 21 ft (6.4 m) beam, powered by twin Caterpillar inboard diesels for assured performance. The fiberglass construction hull, sleeping arrangements for 8, and 6 heads make her an excellent choice for extended cruising at a steady 18 knots with the capability to push to 23 knots when conditions or schedule demand.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What are the performance figures for the E88? A: The yacht delivers a **cruising speed** of 18 kn (20.71 mph) and a **top speed** of 23 kn (26.47 mph).

Q: What engines power the E88? A: She is fitted with **two Caterpillar inboard diesel** engines for dependable propulsion.

Q: How many guests can it accommodate and how many heads are on board?  
A: The vessel offers **accommodations** for **8** and is equipped with **6 heads** .

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The hull is fiberglass construction, while the **deck** is **Fiberglass** .

Q: What are the key capacities on board? A: **Fuel capacity** is **2,700 gal** , and **water capacity** is **500 gal** . For full details and to schedule inspections, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners report that the E88 fulfills its role as a family cruiser, with documented itineraries across the Bahamas and Caribbean. Many owners operate the yacht themselves for weekend escapes and extended vacations, hiring crew when insurance requirements or longer passages make it necessary. The layout is designed for entertaining—an aft deck, salon, flybridge, and bow seating form distinct gathering areas—and owners commonly praise the craftsmanship, abundant dining options, and variety of relaxation spaces; as one owner put it, “I really, really, really love the boat.” Accommodation includes four en suite guest cabins with a full beam master, a country style galley, and a single level salon that together create comfortable liveaboard arrangements. A beach club with a hydraulic swim platform and a lower aft lounge that can serve as a crew mess simplify water access and tender/toy handling for guests.

On the water, reviewers have labeled the E88 an “all weather cruising machine,” noting the favorable motion provided by pronounced chines and strakes. Independent sea trials typically record a comfortable cruise near 18–19 knots (about 2,100 rpm), wide open average speeds in the 21.9–24 knot

range, and an economical sweet spot at 10–11 knots that can extend range to roughly 950–1,400 nautical miles depending on speed and fuel load. Testers also remark on surprisingly good maneuverability at the dock for a yacht of this size, a trait confirmed by owner operators who handle tight berthing themselves.

Service and ongoing maintenance reflect the scale of the yacht's systems and powerplants. The engine room is notably accessible—approaching 9 feet of headroom with ample service space around typical twin Caterpillar C32 ACERT installations. Technicians point out known C32 family service items (such as aftercoolers on early units, coupling wear, and intermittent electrical/starting issues), which makes strict adherence to Caterpillar's recommended maintenance and authorized service important. There are no widespread, model level structural failures reported across the series, though owners should plan for the elevated service and parts costs associated with high power CAT propulsion and large auxiliary systems (stabilizers, hydraulic swim door, HVAC). Owners frequently praise Horizon Yachts for responsive after sales service: "They respond immediately and make me feel important, like a VIP."

## Pros and Cons

---

Pros:

- Sea kindly, all weather performance with a comfortable 18–19 knot cruise and surprisingly nimble handling when docking.
- A family oriented, entertainment friendly interior and exterior arrangement: four en suite cabins, a country kitchen galley, and multiple social zones including the flybridge and beach club with hydraulic platform.
- Good serviceability from nearly 9 ft of engine room headroom to attentive after sales support from Horizon Yachts.

## Cons:

- Twin Caterpillar C32 ACERTs have documented service items (for example, aftercoolers on some early units, coupling wear, and electrical/starting quirks) and require diligent upkeep.
- Many owners elect to add crew for insurance coverage or extended passages, which can reduce opportunities for pure owner operation.
- Achieving the quoted long range numbers (≈950–1,400 nm) typically means running at 10–11 knots and careful fuel management.
