OVERVIEW

The E90 from Horizon Yachts is a 95 ft (28.96 m) luxury motor yacht in the motor yacht class segment, built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull. It is arranged to welcome 8 guests, supported by berths for 2 crew and six heads, offering a balanced mix of onboard comfort and practical capability. Shestakov Yacht Sales represents the model, with broker Andrey Shestakov available to assist with availability and ordering.

Selecting a E90

Opting for the E90 is a logical choice when you want a tried-and-tested design from Horizon Yachts featuring twin CAT diesel inboards, ample tankage for extended cruising, and a broad 21 ft (6.4 m) beam for generous internal volumes. The platform is well suited to family-oriented cruising or executive hosting, delivering the space and functionality expected of a premium motor yacht in the motor yacht class.

- Twin CAT diesel inboard powerplants provide assured, efficient propulsion
- 95 ft LOA with a 21 ft beam creates expansive cabin and deck arrangements
- Deep draft of 17.771 ft (5.4166 m) contributes to capable seakeeping
- 2,700 gal fuel and 500 gal water capacities support extended periods at sea
- Sleeps 8 guests with room for 2 crew and outfitted with 6 heads for privacy and convenience
- Hull built to the fiberglass and plastic standard, complemented by a fiberglass deck

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the E90? A: It is a motor yacht in the motor yacht class segment, engineered to deliver both performance and the comforts expected of a luxury motor yacht.

Q: Who builds the E90? A: The vessel is constructed by Horizon Yachts, a yard noted for high-quality composite work in the fiberglass and plastic category.

Q: What engines power the E90? A: The model is fitted with two **CAT diesel inboard** engines, chosen for dependable propulsion and accessibility to service.

Q: How many people can the E90 accommodate? A: The accommodation plan supports **8 guests** , has berths for **2 crew** , and includes **6 heads** , allowing for privacy and comfortable extended stays.

Q: What are the hull and deck materials? A: The hull is defined as fiberglass and plastic, with a **fiberglass** deck installed for durability and longevity. For comprehensive particulars, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the E90 for the very qualities its reputation highlights. At a Horizon Yachts owners' gathering in the Abacos, one E90 carried the name "Lazy Daze," reflecting a focus on family island cruising and relaxed owner operator weekends centered on entertaining. The vessel's layout reinforces that use with several social areas—an upper deck capable of hosting a hot tub, fold away TV, wet bar and BBQ—and a main deck country galley designed to support serious catering.

Many buyers return to the model to customize interiors and to select skylounge or boat deck configurations, and the design adapts well to both private ownership and owner/crew operational profiles.

On the water, expert reviews note a semi displacement hull tuned for performance, with a typical cruise speed near 20 knots and top speeds in the mid 20s. The yacht remains comfortable at displacement speeds and offers extended range potential—more than 1,000 nm when operated slowly, and about 400 nm when run at higher cruise settings. The enclosed flybridge helm

accepts multi screen navigation setups, delivers very good sightlines, and integrates docking aids such as thruster controls and zip wake style systems.

Daily maintenance is eased by a roomy, logically arranged engine room that provides practical service access. Powerplant packages vary by individual hull—twin Caterpillar C32 variants are common, though some listings cite MAN engines—and warranty coverage is typically tied to each specific sale. Public owner forums have not reported widespread long term failures to date—the fleet remains relatively new and small—so prospective buyers should confirm details through surveys and review service histories.

Pros and Cons

- Flybridge and upper decks are configured for entertaining, with options for a hot tub, wet bar, BBQ, and flexible seating arrangements.
- A full beam amidships master stateroom and a country galley capable of supporting catering enhance onboard liveability for longer voyages.
- Semi displacement hull form provides an approximate 20 knot cruise, mid 20s top speed, and efficient long range operation at slower speeds.
- Range falls to roughly 400 nm at higher cruising speeds compared with over 1,000 nm achievable when steaming slowly.
- Engine packages differ across hulls (CAT C32 is common, with some examples powered by MAN), and warranty or coverage terms can change with each brokerage sale.
- The fleet is relatively new and limited in number, so extensive publicly available long term reliability data is limited.
