## OVERVIEW

---

The FD 87 from Horizon Yachts represents a modern motor yacht within the motor yachts segment, engineered on a fast-displacement hull and finished with a fiberglass hull. Offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this roughly 90-foot platform is designed to balance interior volume, onboard comfort, and confident cruising capability.

## Selecting a FD 87

---

Opting for the FD 87 makes sense if you prioritize a generous 23 ft (7.09 m) beam, sleeping space for eight, and the assurance of twin MTU inboard diesel power. The Fast Displacement Hull is tuned for comfortable passages at a typical 12-knot cruise while retaining reserve performance up to about 14.5 knots. Buyers concentrating on contemporary motor yacht class offerings within the broader motor yachts category will find expert assistance from Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team for specification reviews, sea-trial coordination, and contract negotiations.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What class does the FD 87 belong to? A: It is a motor yacht within the larger motor yachts category. This classification speaks to its focus on **design** , **space** , and **cruising** capability.

Q: What are the speeds of the FD 87? A: The vessel's **cruising speed** is listed as 12 kn (13.81 mph) with a **maximum speed** of 14.5 kn (16.69 mph), characteristics supported by the Fast Displacement Hull form.

Q: How many people can the yacht accommodate? A: The arrangement offers **accommodations for 8** guests with **5 heads** , in addition to **2 crew cabins** for professional crew requirements.

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The hull is built of fiberglass paired with a **GRP deck** , a combination that balances durability and ease of upkeep.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners frequently choose the FD 87 for family-oriented cruising and owner-operated vacations, often combining private use with occasional short-term charters, particularly around The Bahamas. The interior and deck arrangement favors entertaining, with several alfresco living areas, an expansive aft deck, and a genuinely usable beach club — as one owner admitted, “When we first saw the beach club, I thought we would never use it. I was wrong — it’s yet another great place to entertain.” Common owner preferences include five-cabin schemes and a full-beam, on-deck owner’s

stateroom, while the deck salon's full-height glazing and an unusually spacious, adaptable galley receive consistent praise.

On the water, the fast-displacement hull is noted for economical passages near 10 knots with a reported top end close to 19 knots. Skippers describe comfortable operation in 4–6 ft seas at 10–12 knots, and at least one captain has handled conditions exceeding 10 ft with a dry bow and minimal spray. These handling attributes create a stable, seakindly platform suitable for coastal hops and seasonal cruising across regions like the Bahamas, Caribbean, and U.S. East Coast.

Everyday ownership notes emphasize serviceability: the engine room offers roomy access and good ventilation, often with A/C to ease maintenance tasks, and locally common Caterpillar C18 powerplants are supported by routine servicing and parts availability. Owners and captains report attentive Horizon Yachts support during commissioning and initial cruises, and public owner/captain commentary does not reveal persistent, model-specific mechanical issues. Counterbalancing those positives, independent commentary points out the owner's suite can feel underwhelming and that certain deck areas may come across as plain.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Fast-displacement hull delivers efficient cruising around 10 knots with a top near 19 knots and a stable, sea kindly ride.
- Five-cabin layouts with an on-deck owner's suite, a large full-height-glass salon, and a notably generous, flexible galley.
- Spacious, well-ventilated, A/C-equipped engine room, common Caterpillar C18s with service availability, and responsive Horizon Yachts yard support.
- Independent review notes the owner's cabin lacks a wow factor.
- Some decks can feel bland per third-party critique.

- Speed profile centers on economical ~10-knot cruising with a top around 19 knots.
