The yacht's configuration—twin MTU inboard diesels, a fiberglass deck, and factory interiors—creates a dependable platform for longer family cruises and elevated onboard living.

Accommodation is arranged for up to 8 guests alongside dedicated crew quarters in two cabins, offering privacy for owners and seamless service flow; six heads add to onboard ease and convenience.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the Horizon FD80-619 AVAIABLE FLIBS 2026 from Horizon Yachts for its suitability as an owner-operator boat and for family-oriented coastal cruising along the U.S. East Coast and through the Bahamas. The on-deck master stateroom is frequently cited as enabling owner operation. For social weekends and hosting, owners emphasize the bright, airy salon with large windows, the full beach club, and an aft jacuzzi/hot tub; typical four-stateroom arrangements with an enclosed skylounge and a galley that can be closed off with privacy doors support easy entertaining. One owner summed it up as “PLENTY of room... a LOVELY wheelhouse,” also noting a solid electronics fit.

When underway, owners report comfortable, fuel-efficient performance at modest speeds, citing mid-teens cruising numbers and the capability to motor economically on a single engine for extended passages. Manufacturer and owner materials portray the yacht as well-suited to island hopping with a shallow draft, ideal for coastal and Bahamas cruising rather than extended blue-water crossings. Conversely, some forum commentary about the 80' Horizon class calls it a “very poor sea boat” in rougher conditions, with more rolling than some owners prefer.

Maintenance commentary varies: forum posts warn that engine-room access can be tight, making service on generators and systems more time-consuming, while other owners commend the simple, robust redundancy of the systems. Routine upkeep such as stainless polishing and finish care are regular tasks. There is no public, exhaustive long-term operating-cost record; anecdotal discussions indicate that hours spent in the engine room and system troubleshooting are common contributors to ownership costs.

Pros and Cons

- Owner-operator oriented layout with an on-deck master ideal for East Coast and Bahamas cruising.
- Generous, luminous interior with four staterooms, an enclosed skylounge, and a full beach club for entertaining guests.
- Efficient at lower speeds with reported mid-teens cruise performance and the option to run on a single engine for economical passages.
- Some owners and forum posts characterize the 80' Horizon series as a “very poor sea boat” in more challenging seas, noting increased rolling.
- Restricted engine-room access can make servicing generators and systems more labor-intensive.
- Best suited to coastal and island itineraries rather than long-range, true blue-water passagemaking.

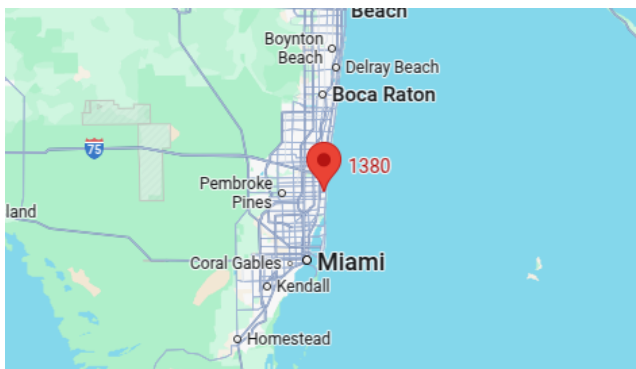
