Built by HURRICANE, the model's single-engine arrangement and robust fiberglass and plastic hull simplify ownership and upkeep. Q: What is the **hull** material? A: The hull falls under the fiberglass and plastic category and features a fiberglass deck surface.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and dealers commonly describe the CC 231 from HURRICANE as a versatile dayboat that works well for families and light fishing. The center-console deck-boat design keeps the cockpit open for easy circulation, with seating arranged fore and aft and numerous lockers for storage. Listings often highlight plentiful storage, an onboard wash sink, large center-console access that accommodates a porta-potty with privacy, a substantial swim platform, and a bimini—features well suited to sandbar stops, swimming, and watersports. Capacity listings of up to 12 people are common and reflect its mixed recreational use.

On the water, seller notes and owner feedback repeatedly point to a steady, comfortable ride in choppy and nearshore conditions; one listing even calls it a "surprisingly great riding hull while cruising in the ocean." Owners of comparable 21–23 ft Hurricanes comment that the boat "corners pretty well." As with most outboard-driven deckboats, actual performance is influenced by the chosen power; the CC 231 is frequently paired with engines in the 150–250 hp range, producing cruising characteristics typical of a 23-foot deckboat.

Everyday ownership tends to be uncomplicated: expect routine outboard service intervals, and note that some used listings advertise a professional 300-hour service completion. A variety of engine fits appear on the market (for example, Suzuki DF150 and Yamaha F250), so maintenance planning should reflect the installed powerplant. Owners commonly report modest upgrades—new batteries, GPS/fishfinder installations—and some have needed bimini or cover hardware and support-strut parts, which are often sourced locally for tubing and fittings. These observations are drawn mainly from

dealer and owner listings rather than controlled sea-trial data, yet they remain consistent across multiple sources.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile dayboat arrangement ideal for family outings, sandbar downtime, watersports, and nearshore/inshore fishing.
- Ride quality frequently reported as stable and smooth in chop, with good cornering characteristics.
- Generous storage, onboard wash sink, roomy console for porta potty privacy, bimini, and a large swim platform.
- Performance and fuel economy are influenced considerably by outboard selection and installation.
- Designed primarily for inshore and nearshore activity rather than extended offshore passages.
- Bimini/top hardware and certain support strut components may need to be sourced or replaced periodically.
