## OVERVIEW

---

The 55 by HYATT is a multi-purpose motor yacht in the wider category of motor yachts, built on a hull of fiberglass and plastic. Represented internationally by Shestakov Yacht Sales, broker Andrey Shestakov is available to support acquisitions, listings, and survey inspections.

## Selecting a 55

---

Opting for the 55 places emphasis on comfortable cruising with a well-rounded set of onboard conveniences and dependable propulsion. Powered by twin Caterpillar inboard diesels, featuring a substantial 16 ft beam and sleeping arrangements for five with two heads, this yacht is ideal for family outings and relaxed coastal passages at an economical 12 knots. Coordinate with Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team to review floorplan variations, plan desired upgrades, and locate the finest examples on the market.

## Features of the Model

---

- Twin Caterpillar inboard diesel engines provide reliable propulsion and serviceability
- Efficient cruising at approximately 12 kn (13.81 mph)
- Accommodation for 5 passengers with 2 heads to support family and guest use
- Overall length of 55 ft (16.79 m) paired with a roomy 16 ft (4.88 m) beam
- Hull constructed from fiberglass and plastic with a fiberglass deck for longevity and ease of maintenance
- Well-proportioned tankage with 250 gal fuel and 250 gal freshwater capacity

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What type of yacht is the 55? A: It is a motor yacht within the broader class of motor yachts, well suited to **cruising** and adaptable family use.

Q: Who is the builder of the 55? A: The vessel is produced by HYATT, a yard recognized for **reliable construction** and functional interior arrangements.

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: The 55 has a **55 ft LOA**

(16.79 m), a **16 ft beam** (4.88 m) and a **13.944 ft max draft** (4.25 m). Tankage includes **250 gal fuel** and **250 gal water** .

Q: What engines and performance should I expect? A: Propulsion is provided by **2 x Caterpillar inboard diesel** engines, yielding a typical **cruising speed** of 12 kn (13.81 mph).

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The hull is built of fiberglass and plastic and the deck is **fiberglass** , selected for durability and simplified upkeep. For a full condition assessment and inspection details, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and brokers regularly recommend the 55 from HYATT as a practical choice for family-oriented coastal cruising and leisurely weekend getaways. Advertised layouts commonly list three cabins accommodating roughly five people alongside two heads, complemented by a convivial aft deck and a salon engineered for entertaining. The upper helm or wheelhouse typically features an expansive wraparound bench with A/C, and the aft deck's seating converts into a double berth; Eisenglass enclosures are often fitted to lengthen seasonal use.

When underway buyers can expect a focus on comfort over speed. Published operating figures place cruising near 12 knots, and the solid fiberglass hull delivers a composed, predictable ride at displacement speeds rather than planing performance.

For extended coastal runs or part time liveaboard operation with a small crew, the systems and fit-out are frequently highlighted: a full galley with a full size refrigerator, two burner stove, microwave, oven and generous storage; multiple air conditioning units; and propulsion and service equipment such as

twin Caterpillar 3208 diesels, two generators (approximately 9 kW aft and 21 kW main), and a 20 gph watermaker. Recent maintenance notes from listings include an April 2023 haul out with fresh antifouling and new cutlass bearings, a Muir anchor windlass installed in 2020, new batteries in 2022, and a bow thruster reported as requiring repair; prospective buyers should carefully review the service records for the generators and the watermaker.

## Pros and Cons

- Three cabins and two heads accommodate family cruising and overnight visitors.
- Comfortable, steady performance near 12 knots with a durable fiberglass hull at displacement speeds.
- Functional cruising features include a full galley, a 20 gph watermaker, multiple A/C zones, and sociable aft and upper helm spaces.
- The design is not intended for high speed operation; passage planning assumes displacement cruising.
- Some listings indicate the bow thruster requires repair and will need attention.
- Buyers are advised to confirm maintenance history for the two generators and the 20 gph watermaker.
